5. MEMBERS' ITEM – BUS STOP ON THE 382 ROUTE TOWARDS FINCHLEY CENTRAL IN SUMMERS LANE N12 NEAR SUNNY WAY (Report of the Head of Governance – Agenda Item 5a)

The Sub-Committee heard Councillor Geof Cooke's representation regarding the decision not to proceed with the planned bus stop on the 382 route towards Finchley Central in Summers Lane N12 near Sunny Way in view of the strong expression of support for the proposal from local residents.

RESOLVED –

- (1) That the Cabinet Member be asked to reconsider the decision not to proceed with the planned bus stop.

- (2) That the Cabinet Member be asked to consider instructing the Interim Director of Environment, Planning and Regeneration to resurrect the scheme in its original form or explore the option of a hail and ride scheme.
- (3) That a report on the outcome be brought to the next meeting of the Sub-Committee.

- (3) That the Sub-Committee notes the results of the public consultation exercise and the revised text and maps for the Finchley Church End Conservation Area Character Appraisal and Management Proposals.
