9. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 9.1 Councillor Geoffrey Johnson has requested that a Member's Item be put on the agenda of this Sub-Committee in the following terms:

Parking Colindale Ward NW9

Woodfield Avenue, Hillfield Avenue and Silkfield Road are all narrow roads. Consequently for many years residents have parked half on the tarmac verge and half on the road to enable passing traffic especially large and emergency vehicles to access and egress these roads. Recently residents here have been subjected to parking control and have received large numbers of PCN's. Residents feel this is very unfair especially as the grass verges were tarmacked by Barnet Council so that they could be used for parking.

In other parts of the Borough and in New Way Road which is in this area boxes have been implemented to facilitate this method of parking. Residents from the mentioned streets have requested that this system be introduced in their roads in the interest of road safety and to assist the flow of passing traffic especially emergency vehicles, otherwise there will be chaos as there was on the 27th January when the refuse lorry was unable to access the road due to parked cars.
