9. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 9.1 Councillor, Joan Scannell has requested that a Member's Item be considered as set out at 9.2.
- 9.2 Councillor Joan Scannell notes that:

Many residents in Broadfields Avenue (between the A41 and Hale Lane) Edgware, are experiencing the following problems:-

1. *Traffic congestion.*
2. *Difficulty in entering/exiting their drives because of cars parked, partly across their drives.*
3. *Difficulty in entering/exiting their drives because lorries and 4x4's are parked are obscuring their sightlines.*
4. *Lorries using the road early in the mornings before the time allowed.*
5. *Are calling for the CPZ to be extended to the whole road.*

Councillor Joan Scannell therefore requests that the Hendon Area Sub-Committee consider this and what improvements can be made as set out within its terms of reference.
