Recycling reprocessing arrangements	<p><u>Description</u> The council requires a reprocessing outlet for the recyclable materials to be collected from households and recycling banks from 7 October 2013, in readiness for the launch of new in-house waste and recycling collection services from 14 October 2013. A recent procurement exercise has not delivered the expected cost-effective options, and the report seeks agreement for the council to work with the North London Waste Authority to put in place arrangements for the reprocessing of recyclable materials.</p> <p><u>Reason for Urgency</u> Arrangements for the reprocessing of recyclable materials must be in place for 7 October, and there is no prospect of a suitable and timely alternative from the market.</p>	Cllr Dean Cohen	Yes	Yes
