The Lead Officer explained that the information from CCTV systems was shared with the Police and moreover the systems had been upgraded and that a viewing platform had now been installed in Colindale Police Station to ensure fast access to the Police was available.

The Lead Officer said that to counter the negative perception of residents, more would be done in the future to communicate to residents and shop owners that the Council was proactively tackling crime.
