General points

The following procedure is based on Regulations made by the Secretary of State under the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Hearings Regulations") which may be viewed or downloaded from the website of the Department for Culture, Media and Sport by following links from www.culture.gov.uk

The procedure is intended as a general framework to ensure natural justice and a fair hearing. The conduct of individual hearings may vary slightly according to circumstances and the discretion of the Chairman. In all cases, however, this general framework will be followed.

The procedure allows each party a maximum period of 5 minutes in which to present their case (Regulations 16 & 24). At the end of the time allowed, the Chairman will terminate the presentation and the hearing will proceed in the form of a discussion led by the authority to explore points of dispute. The discussion will not be timed.

The procedure is subject to periodic review and amendment to reflect best practice and relevant legislative changes. An updated version of this procedure is published as soon as possible following any such amendments.

Governance Officer

- To seek nominations for Chairman
- Elect Chairman
- Hand over to the Chairman

Chairman

- Introduces him/herself and Members of the Committee, and outlines their roles.
- Introduces Licensing, Legal and Governance Officer.
- Explains that Legal and Governance Officers will be present during the Committee's deliberations to advise only, and that the Licensing Officer will be excluded from deliberations.
- Asks parties present to introduce themselves.
- Outlines procedure to be followed.
- Asks all parties to confirm their understanding of the procedure.
- Clarifies any aspect(s) of the procedure where any parties are uncertain or asks Legal or Governance Officer as appropriate to clarify.

Governance Officer

- Informs Committee of absent parties.
- Details persons whom a party is seeking permission to represent them at hearing.
- Panel confer regarding permission.
- Chairman announces decision regarding permission.

Licensing Officer presents the report to the Committee

 Is a statement of the facts including details of the application and operating schedule, relevant policy details, detail representations made, a chronology of events and highlights the points on which the Authority requires clarification.

Applicant

 Presents opening submissions and clarifies points raised by Authority in notice of hearing. Time allowed 5 mins.

Other parties

 Presents opening submissions either in person or by spokes person Time allowed 5 mins per interested party.

Note regarding use of video evidence

Video evidence must be in DVD format and will form part of the relevant party's five minutes opening submission. Any party wishing to use video evidence must submit a copy to the Authority along with sufficient, identical extra copies to serve on all the opposing parties – i.e. if the applicant is submitting it, there must be enough copies for all parties making representations and if a party making representations is submitting it there must be a copy for the applicant. The recording must be edited down to the highlights, containing only relevant matter which relates to the written representation previously submitted. In addition, a description of how, when and where the video was recorded and what it contains must be submitted. These must be supplied to the Authority at least five working days before the hearing.

Members question Licensing Officer on Policy

Discussion

Chairman leads a discussion concentrating on points of dispute:

Chairman asks Applicant what he disputes in other parties' submissions, and asks other parties to comment.

Chairman proceeds through all objectors dealing with all matters of contention.

When Chairman feels all matters have been thoroughly discussed and all parties have been given a fair and equal opportunity to comment and make representations, she/he closes discussion.

Determination

There are two procedures depending on whether or not determination is to be made at the end of the Hearing or within five working days of the Hearing. This later announcement of determination is permitted in terms of the Legislation for certain types of applications.

<u>Chairman</u> informs all present that the Committee will deliberate, that Legal and Governance Officer will remain to advise but will not be part of decision-making process, and that all others must leave (under Regulation 14).

- Parties, apart from Legal and Governance Officer, leave the room.
- The Committee deliberates, with advice as required from Legal and Governance Officer, and reaches a conclusion. The Legal officer may assist, as required, in formulating the wording of the determination.
- Parties return.
- Chairman reads out determination, and advises it will be sent in ⁶

- writing to all parties.
- Opportunity for determination to be clarified by any interested party who is unclear.
- Chairman gives advice about appealing against the determination.
- Chairman thanks all for attending and closes the meeting.

...Within five working days of the hearing

- Chairman explains requirement to determine the Hearing within five workings days, and advises that the Committee will proceed to deliberate and announce the determination within that time.
- During deliberations, Legal and Governance Officers remain to advise on law and procedure as required. The Legal Officer may assist, as required, in formulating the wording of the determination. The Licensing Officer plays no part in the determination and withdraws for this part of the proceedings.
- Chairman advises all parties that they will receive written notification of the determination within five working days of the Hearing date, together with general information on how to appeal against the determination.
- Chairman thanks all parties for attending and invites the applicant, objector(s), other party(ies) and the Licensing Officer to leave.

Information on Appealing against the decision

You may at any time before the expiration of a period of 21 days from notification appeal to Willesden Magistrates' Court, 448 High Road London England NW10 2DZ (Telephone 020 8955 0555, DX 110850 Willesden 2) by way of Complaint for an Order. The Court may either dismiss the appeal, substitute for the decision appealed against any other decision which could have been made by the Licensing Authority or remit the case to the Licensing Authority to dispose of it in accordance with the directions of the court, and can make such order as to costs as it thinks fit.

1. The Applicants

The application was submitted by RE consultancy on behalf of Assad Hussaini Basmenj.

2. Application

The application before the subcommittee was submitted under Section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003 for a New Premises Licence. The application seeks to allow the following:

- To allow the sale of alcohol for consumption on the premises only from 11:00hrs until 00:30hrs (the following morning) Monday to Sunday
- To allow performance of live music (indoors only) from 18:00hrs until 22:00hrs Friday and Saturday.
- To allow playing of recorded music (indoors only) from 18:00hrs until 22:00hrs Friday and Saturday.
- To allow the provision of late night refreshment (indoors only) from 23:00hrs until 01:00hrs (the following morning) Monday to Sunday.
- To allow the premises to remain open to the public from 11:00hrs until 01:00hrs (the following morning) Monday to Sunday.

A full copy of the application can be seen attached to this report in **Annex 1**.

3. Representations

Responsible Authorities

The Licensing Team have received a representation from PC John Akers on behalf of the Metropolitan Police, their representation relates to the prevention of crime and disorder. We also received a representation from Roxanne Patemen on behalf of the London Borough of Barnet Noise Nuisance team, their representation relates to the prevention of public nuisance.

Other representations

The Licensing Team have received 2 valid representations from members of the public, these relate to the prevention of public nuisance.

The representation can be seen attached to this report in **Annex 2**.

4. Attaching conditions

The operating schedule, which is part of the application, includes certain additional steps that the applicant will take to protect the licensing objectives. These will become enforceable conditions, should the licence be granted. Additional conditions may be attached to the licence if the committee thinks it appropriate.

The Committee must have regard to all of the representations made and the evidence it hears, and is asked to note that it may not attach conditions or reject the whole or part of the application merely because it considers it desirable to do so. It must actually be appropriate in order to promote the licensing objectives.

In relation to conditions, the statutory guidance at chapter 10.8 states that "The licensing authority may not impose any conditions unless its discretion has been engaged following receipt of relevant representations and it is satisfied as a result of a hearing (unless all parties agree a hearing is not necessary) that it is appropriate to impose conditions to promote one or more of the four licensing objectives.

Full Copies of the Councils Statement of Licensing Policy, the Statutory Guidance to the Act and the Council's Guide to Good Practice at Licensed Premises will be available at the Licensing Sub Committee hearing or in advance if required.

A map centrally locating the premises and a plan shall be made available at the hearing.



The Noise Nuisance team are satisfied that allowing this premise to be used in accordance with the application submitted would undermine the licensing objective of the Prevention of Public Nuisance.

Our records show there have been a number of complaints made to Environmental Health of loud amplified music from this premises since 2014. Officers from the Out of Hour's Noise team at Barnet Council witnessed loud amplified music emanating from this premise on the 21.01.2017 which resulted in an Abatement Notice under section 80 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 being served as the music was deemed to be a statutory noise nuisance. The notice requires the owner/manager of the premises cease or cause to cease the playing of amplified music and speech at such a level as to cause a statutory noise nuisance to neighbouring residents. Since the service of this notice the Out of Hour's Noise team have witnessed three breaches of this notice on the 8.01.2017, 18.02.2017 and the 25.02.2017.

This clearly demonstrates that recorded and live music is not suitable for this premise as it is causing a significant on-going nuisance to a number of neighbouring residents.

A meeting was held with the applicant and the noise team on the 23rd February 2017. During which he was advised to engage the services of a reputable noise consultant in order to obtain what noise proofing methods are required to ensure the prevention of a nuisance arising from this premises.

Until such a time that a noise report is submitted to the noise team and agreed works are undertaken to prevent the continued noise nuisance from this premises I would respectfully request that the Licensing Sub Committee rejects the application or

amends the application to remove live and recorded music and condition no live or recorded music is permitted at any time.
