The Application

This application seeks to transfer the premises licence under section 42 of the Licensing Act 2003 from Mr Giyasettin Top to Mr Suleyan Tekagac of 121 East Barnet Road, EN4 8RF. The Application was submitted by Mr Tekagac by Kent Solicitors.

A copy of the Transfer Application can be found in Annex 1 attached to this report.

Representation

The police having been provided with a copy of the application have provided the Licensing Authority with their representation. This was received by the licensing authority on Thursday 12th June 2014.

The Police have stated that the proposed premises licence holder has been convicted and charged with several offences most of which seem to have involved violent behaviour towards other people and police.

As a result the police have also stated that they are of the opinion that the applicant is not of suitable character to be allowed to hold the premises licence for the venue stated on this application. As a result the have respectfully requested that the Licensing

Officer Comments - Statutory Guidance

8.92 The 2003 Act provides for any person who may apply for a premises licence, which includes a business, to apply for a premises licence to be transferred to them. Where the application is made in writing, the applicant must give notice of the application to the chief officer of police. Where it is made electronically via GOV.UK or the licensing authority's electronic facility, the licensing authority must notify the police no later than the first

working day after the application is given. However, the responsibility to notify the DPS remains with the applicant. Otherwise the general guidance on electronic applications set out in paragraphs 8.21 to 8.28 applies.

- 8.93 In the vast majority of cases, it is expected that a transfer will be a very simple administrative process. Section 43 of the 2003 Act provides a mechanism which allows the transfer to come into immediate interim effect as soon as the licensing authority receives it, until it is formally determined or withdrawn. This is to ensure that there should be no interruption to normal business at the premises. If the police raise no objection about the application, the licensing authority must transfer the licence in accordance with the application, amend the licence accordingly and return it to the new holder.
- 8.94 In exceptional circumstances where the chief officer of police believes the transfer may undermine the crime prevention objective, the police may object to the transfer. Such objections are expected to be rare and arise because the police have evidence that the business or individuals seeking to hold the licence or business or individuals linked to such persons are involved in crime (or disorder).
- 8.95 Such objections (and therefore such hearings) should only arise in truly exceptional circumstances. If the licensing authority believes that the police are using this mechanism to vet transfer applicants routinely and to seek hearings as a fishing expedition to inquire into applicants' backgrounds, it is expected that it would raise the matter immediately with the chief officer of police.



Representations:

The Police representations are concerned with the previous criminal history of the applicant.

The applicant has been convicted and charged with several offences most of which seem to involve violent behaviour towards other people and police.

The applicant has been convicted of Battery, Theft, Public order offences and Possession of an offensive weapon. These offences has been stretched over a period of time from 2008 until 2012 suggesting that this is a trait for the applicant rather than a one of incident. The applicant has also been arrested for Grevious Bodily Harm and another very serious offence. In both these instances the allegations were not continued with.

The applicant has also come to police notice very recently via stops made by police and allegations against him that have left the police trying to issue him with a Harrasment Order.

It is of the opinion of the police that the applicant is not of suitable character to be allowed to hold the premises licence at the venue stated on the application and as a result the Police respectfully request that the Licensing Sub Committee reject this application for the reasons mentioned and in order to promote the licensing objectives.
