6.	<b>What is the project?</b> Please provide a brief overview of the project and what the funding will be used for. <p>Since the Club was formed its members individually paid fees to the Council. This all changed in late July 2016 when the Club was informed that the Council expected the Club become self-managing by 1<sup>st</sup> April 2017' Whilst all members appreciate the reason behind this order, they also realise the time allowed was unrealistic.</p> <p>The recruitment of new members cannot start until early April – who would read a leaflet in the cold of Winter and rush to join an outdoor club?. Not getting new members is a problem shared throughout the country within Bowling Clubs.</p> <p>We have planned a massive campaign; local papers, a 5000 leaflet drop to households throughout Mill Hill, posters, we hope, in all shops and then members handing out leaflets outside nearby stations and supermarkets. All this will cost money.</p> <p>Banners to hang around the green have been ordered, again more money.</p> <p>In addition we have the normal overheads of any club or organisation i.e. insurance, affiliation fees, green and clubhouse maintenance, plus utilities etc..</p> <p>Transformation does not happen quickly. We know the club can become self-managing but we will need assistance in the first year</p>
