	Residents are frequently raising with their local councillors the rising amount of repeat fly-tipping in locations in certain wards and across the Borough. Areas affected by enviro-crime appear neglected and this neglect encourages other forms of crime, impacting upon perceived and actual community safety.
	Yet environmental crime has disappeared as a specific aspect of community safety in the Committee on Community Leadership's remit, at a time when the problem appears at unprecedented levels in our Borough.
	I request that this omission is addressed and that a report is brought to the next CLLC meeting to consider a comprehensive and effective communications programme on education and enforcement on this important local dimension to community safety.
