Brexit and Barnet

Add at the end:

Council notes the growing feeling of uncertainty and concern about what will be in the final Brexit deal as demonstrated by this month's 'People's Vote March' in central London which was attended by councillors from both political Groups on Barnet Council.

Council agrees with the sentiments behind the 'People's Vote March', that democracy does not end with one vote and that people's views on both sides of the EU membership debate may change once the final Brexit deal is known.

Council believes it would be wrong to deny the British people, including Barnet residents, a say on the final Brexit deal.

Council asks the Chief Executive to write to the Government making LB Barnet's position on this clear.
