



STATUTORY NOTICE

Proposal to establish a new Voluntary Aided primary school

Notice is given that the Finchley Jewish Primary School Trust (the “Proposer”) who are the Trustees of Morasha Jewish Primary School, 37 Moss Hall Grove, London N12 8PE intend to establish a New Voluntary Aided School (the “School”) under section 11(2) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, as amended by the Education Act 2011.

It is proposed that the School will open on 1 April 2013.

The School will be situated at 31 Stanhope Road, Barnet, London, N12 9DX and 37 Moss Hall Grove, London N12 8PE. When all year groups have been admitted, five classes will be situated at 31 Stanhope Road and two classes will be situated at 37 Moss Hall Grove. The School will serve the Jewish community of the London Borough of Barnet and adjoining Boroughs.

The School will be conducted in accordance with the ethics and principles of the Jewish religion and culture. The School will have a Jewish religious character and it is confirmed that the Proposer intends to ask the Secretary of State to designate the School as a school with such a religious character.

It is intended that additional facilities will be made available, where practical and in line with planning conditions, to the local community and to the Jewish community. These include breakfast clubs, lunchtime clubs, after school clubs, adult learning classes and family learning.

The School will cater for pupils between the ages of 4 and 11 and provide places for 210 boys and girls. The admission number for each class in the School on the opening date will be 30.


In admissions to the School, preference will be given to those children whose families regularly attend Finchley United Synagogue (Kinloss) and whose families are able to demonstrate commitment to Orthodox Jewish observances and practices as verified by way of a form to be completed by the Rabbi of the Synagogue at which the members of the family are regular attendees.

In the event of any dispute, the decision as to whether or not an applicant qualifies for priority consideration will be based on the information provided by the applicant on the School’s Supplementary Information Form (SIF). The oversubscription criteria are shown in the detailed admissions arrangements in the complete proposal.

Transport to both of the School sites will be by foot, car and/or public transport.
