This is the only mention of smoking in the plan, even though it causes 75,000 deaths each year in England and costs the NHS England an estimated £2.6 billion annually. I would like to ask the board to commit to implementing a smoking ban in outside spaces where food and drinks are served, which will improve the environment outside cafes and bars for non-smokers and help to improve the health of smokers.
