You have a substantial interest if you own shares or other securities in the company with a nominal value of more than £25,000 or if you own more than 1/100th of the issued shares or securities. If there are several classes of shares or securities, the fraction of 1/100th applies to any of those classes. These limits also apply to deposits with industrial and provident societies, and cooperative societies.

A company or body corporate is active in the borough if it has land or a place of business in the borough.

The requirement also covers shares and securities in which you have a beneficial interest even though they are held in the name or names of other people. You have a beneficial interest in a type of share if you own or are entitled to the proceeds, or if through a trust or will, you become entitled to the proceeds of that type of share.

Dear Mr. Lustig,

Following our conversation after the last Council meeting, I am writing to confirm that the following Councillors attended one of the Ageing Well 2 Day courses at Warwick University:- Cllr Graham Old, Cllr Bridget Perry, Cllr Kate Salinger, Cllr Barry Rawlings, Cllr Joan Scannell, Cllr Geoff Johnson, Cllr Julie Johnson and myself. These 2 day courses are usually charged at £500. As we all travelled up the evening before the start of the course, an extra £80 to cover an extra overnight stay, together with dinner and breakfast, should be added to the £500.

Cllr Sury Khatri and Cllr Kate Salinger attended one of the 1 Day Seminars and Cllr Graham Old and myself attended numerous 1 Day Seminars: these were all held in central London. As the Department of Work and Pensions had the right to charge LBB £75 if we had booked for any of the 1 day events and did not turn up on the day, that should be the notional cost of a 1 day seminar.

All of the events arranged for the 'Ageing Well' programme were free of charge to the attendees and were completely funded by the DWP. All that the attendees had to pay for was their transport to the various locations.
