DOLLIS VALLEY ESTATE REGENERATION – UNDERWRITING AGREEMENT WITH WARDEN HOUSING ASSOCIATION (CRC Dec. 4/11/2004 – 13 & 25/11/2004 – 15) (Report of the Cabinet Member for Housing, Neighbourhoods & Community Safety – Agenda Item 4)

For the reasons set out in the Cabinet Member's report, and having regard to the revisions to the draft agreement made in response to the concerns made by members at previous meetings, the Committee

RESOLVED - That approval be given to enter into the proposed underwriting agreement with Warden Housing Association.

OPEN SPACE AT THE JUNCTION OF DEANSBROOK ROAD AND CRISPIN ROAD BURNT OAK – CONSTRUCTION OF TEMPORARY WORKS COMPOUND (HAESC Dec. 30/11/2004 – 5) (Report of the Cabinet Members concerned – Agenda Item 5)

For the reasons set out in the Cabinet Member's report, the Committee

RESOLVED - That, having given proper consideration to the representations received, it be agreed that the grant of a lease of part of the public open space at the junction of Crispin Road and Deansbrook Road should proceed for the purpose of constructing a temporary works compound upon the basis set out in the report and that the Borough Solicitor be instructed to complete the matter in a form to his approval.

6. SALE OF COUNCIL'S FREEHOLDS: 106/108/110 & 118 BURNT OAK BROADWAY AND 15, 30 & 32 WATLING AVENUE (Report of the Cabinet Members concerned – Agenda Item 6)

RESOLVED – That the negotiated offers from the head lessees of the five properties as set out in the exempt report for the purchase of the freehold interests of properties in Burnt Oak Broadway and Watling Avenue be accepted, and that the Borough Solicitor be instructed to complete the sales in forms to his approval.

MAINTAINED NURSERY CLASSES AT PRIMARY SCHOOLS (Cab. Dec. 29/9/2003 – 4) (Report of the Cabinet Member for Education & Lifelong Learning – Agenda Item 7)

RESOLVED -

- 1. That the private nursery schools attached to Hasmonean, Independent Jewish Day, Menorah Foundation and Rosh Pinah be re-established as maintained nursery provision with effect from 1st September 2005.
- 2. That the estimated revenue cost of incorporating these nurseries into the maintained sector (£101,300) be financed from the budget identified for new nursery classes in the Education Forward Plan 2005/06 (which equates to £312,000); being part of the overall Schools Block Budget.
- That subject to governors' successful capital bid from the LEA Controlled Voluntary-Aided Schools Programme nursery provision be agreed at one Church of England School with effect from 1st April 2006.
- 4. That, subject to 1, the relevant consultation process with all interested parties (including the School Organisation Committee) be fulfilled.

8. REDEVELOPMENT OF PARKFIELD PRIMARY SCHOOL AND CONSTRUCTION OF NEW CHILDREN'S CENTRE (Report of the Cabinet Member for Education & Lifelong Learning – Item 8)

 - (a) the proposals set out in the report to replace the existing Parkfield School premises with new purpose-designed accommodation to current DfES standards, for two Forms of Entry, be approved.

- (b) the construction of a new purpose-designed Children's Centre, to contemporary DfES standards, be approved, as an integral part of the above redevelopment.
- 3. That the Chief Education Officer be instructed to start the procurement process for the project.
