Issue 11 – Action Notes of 15 September 2010	Response to Issue 11 on the Action Sheets regarding a request for an update on the CPZ review. Neil Richardson
	Analysis of the review is complete and conclusions drawn. Based on this it was anticipated that internal consultation with local ward members on the recommended actions resulting from this review would have taken place to inform the final outcome as part of the decision making process.
	Subsequently though, the council's review of all activities related to funding streams for parking schemes and the interest and possible avenues of investigation related to the Barnet Town Centre strategy has meant that no further action as a direct result of the review will be taken for the foreseable future, although the information gathered from the survey may be used to assist some elements of the strategy outcomes where applicable.
