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Appendix - 2016/17 LIP Annual Spending Submission proposals

Corridors, Neighbourhoods and Supporting Measures (CNSM)

When the delivery plan was produced an expected LIP allocation figure for 2014/15 was available from TfL. Some information was also available regarding future year LIP funding which was also used to inform the delivery plan. It subsequently emerged that the 2014/15 formula allocation for the CNSM programme would be less than advised and this also had some impact on assumptions regarding the 2015/16 and 2016/17 funding.

The 2015/16 Annual Spending Submission (ASS) made adjustments to the proposals contained within the programme of investment associated with the LIP Delivery Plan, including associated adjustments to the likely 2016/17 requirements. At the time the formula allocation for 2016/17 for CNSM was uncertain. The 2016/17 expected formula allocation for CNSM has now been advised and is £3,413 (compared with a figure of £3,538k identified in the 2015/16 September 2014 Environment Committee report and the 2015/16 ASS).

The undeveloped proposal for 'Future regeneration priorities' included for 2016/17 in the delivery plan table of investment has been reduced to manage the anticipated level of funding, and split to address a series of individual proposals broadly consistent with the original description. Proposed changes to 2016/17 proposals from the position identified in the September 2014 Environment Committee report and the 2015/16 ASS and the reasons for these are identified in table 1 below in **red and underlined**.

Some proposals are expected to be funded from other sources in addition to LIP funding – these are identified by the abbreviations below.

MAQF – Mayor's Air Quality Scheme - note no MAQF included for 2016/17, but possibility that MAQF round 2 scheme may need match funding – not included below

BCP – TfL's Borough Cycle Programme

S106 – Developer s106 funding

Principal Road Renewal Funding: The indicative allocation for Principal Roads for 2016/17 in Barnet is £1,344k. TfL recommend making funding applications for schemes about 25% above this value to enable reserve schemes to be readily brought forward if required. Proposals based on the condition survey results for the borough are identified in table 2 below.

Bridge Assessment and Strengthening: Submissions will be made based on need identified from inspection reports. These are prioritised and funding awarded according to pan-London requirements.

Local Transport Funding: £100k is provided to each borough for any transport purpose. The LIP delivery plan identifies that in Barnet this will be used for Borough Road Resurfacing. Locations will be identified from condition surveys as for borough funded road resurfacing.

Major Scheme Funding: Major scheme funding is subject to a separate bidding process. Any proposals would also be referenced as appropriate in the ASS.
