1	15	Mr G Roots	At agenda item 15, regarding Barnet Museum (under 5.1.3 'Implications of Decision') it is stated that: 'the BMLHS Business Plan was and has been further developed in response to' Barnet Council's Museum Consultation Document', which presented the case for the ongoing development of Barnet Museum'. Please tell me why this 'Museum Consultation Document' does not appear on the Barnet Council website?	<p>a. Engage Barnet was launched on the 30/11/2010 and as such, this consultation document would not have ever appeared on the central website.</p> <p>b. Prior to that date there was no central location or place where service specific consultations would be put.</p>
2	15	Mr G Roots	It is possible that the 'document' cited is that which contained the responses to the so-called 'public consultation' held in 2010, which included questions about the continuance of funding of both Barnet Museum and Church Farmhouse Museum. Deliberately under-publicized and brief as that consultation was, the answers showed that the vast majority of respondents wanted to keep both museums. That 'document' disappeared from the Barnet Consultations list in 2011, and although the results of all other past 'Consultations' are still available on the Barnet website, that one, curiously, has since been unavailable. Please explain, in detail. why?	<p>We attach a copy of that document which is still available on the internet, although not as a webpage on the Councils website.</p> <p>The Council have had a re- launch/refresh of the website a couple of times in the last six years, which cleaned out a lot of redundant pages, so it is possible that the document was taken down during that process.</p> <p>Please note, there are no responses attached to this document, as none were registered on the website.</p> <p>The paper in question can be accessed via the link below. http://btconnecthosting.com/barnetmuseum/Museums%20Consultation.pdf</p>
