Following this request a consultation was undertaken with residents and local businesses. Details of this can be found using this link Road Traffic Acts The Gazette which was advertised on the 4 November 2021.</i></p> <p><i>Following a consultation, all comments and objections are reviewed prior to determine whether to proceed with the proposals with or without modification, or not to proceed.</i></p> <p><i>We are aware the scheme may have caused an inconvenience to residents and businesses who have been accustomed to parking on Forumside over the years. In this instance, the engineer's decision was to proceed with the measures due to the safety risk to residents.</i></p>
