1.	<p><b>Issue: Consultation results – West Heath Drive, West Heath Avenue and West Heath Road</b>  Resident: Saman Alaghehband  Ward: Childs Hill  Details:  The results of the recent survey and consultation concerning our road (West Heath Drive) and the adjacent West Heath Avenue and West Heath Road have not aligned with residents' expectations.</p> <p>Late last year, the traffic calming measures were discussed in person with Highways Officers and ward Councillor, seeking a final resolution. The problem of speeding has been a longstanding concern, initially raised with Cllr Zinkin. The 2019 speed survey independently highlights this issue with much more detail.</p> <p>Many residents, including myself, strongly believe that immediate action is necessary to implement traffic calming measures.</p>	<p>Thank you for raising a resident issue to the West Area Committee regarding traffic calming measures for West Heath Road/Avenue/Drive.</p> <p>This location has been reviewed under the Highways Road Safety &amp; Parking programme. Following approval to undertake a feasibility study, the study identified a requirement to progress with the introduction of appropriate measures.</p> <p>Having reviewed these measures with ward members, Engineers have sought approval for funding to progress this scheme. A Chief Officer Decision report has been signed by the Director of Highways &amp; Transportation for agreed funding for the implementation of a 20mph on the entire scheme. Furthermore, buildouts as horizontal traffic calming measures along West Heath Road to reduce speed. The scheme will proceed to design and statutory consultation. Following the statutory consultation, Engineers are required to review all comments and objections received and provide their recommendation to proceed with the proposed scheme, with or without modification or not to proceed.</p> <p>The results of the statutory consultation will be shared with ward members along with the Engineers recommendation.</p>
