7. REMOVAL OF NEW BEVAN COMMUNITY CHURCH, GROVE ROAD, BARNET EN4 9DF AS AN ASSET OF COMMUNITY VALUE

The Governance Officer presented the key elements from the report and highlighted the main points, based on the statutory criteria set out in the Localism Act 2011, and the evidence provided in the nomination.

The Sub Committee **RESOLVED** unanimously:

That the Sub-Committee agreed that New Bevan Community Church, Grove Road, Barnet EN4 9DF should be removed as an Asset of Community Value and removed from the Council's Register, as it no longer meets the statutory criteria set out in the Localism Act 2011, and based on the evidence provided.

8. LORD NELSON PUBLIC HOUSE 14 WEST END LANE BARNET EN5 2SA

The Governance Officer presented the key elements from the report and highlighted the main points, based on the statutory criteria set out in the Localism Act 2011, and the evidence provided in the nomination.

Members were requested to note that an application was received on 29 July for a community right to bid for this Lord Nelson Public House from Mr Andrew Robinson who has made the application on behalf of 33 local residents.

Mr Andrew Robinson was in attendance and gave a verbal representation in support of the application. Ward Members Councillor Zahra Beg and Councillor Tim Roberts gave a verbal representation in support of the application.

Members had the opportunity to consider the report and ask questions to the speaker. In doing so it was noted that Mr Andrew Robinson was a member of Campaign for Real Ale. Mr Andrew Robinson noted that there were some supporting groups that were constituted.

The Sub Committee **RESOLVED** unanimously:

That the Committee approved the listing of the Lord Nelson as an Asset of Community Value, based on the statutory criteria set out in the Localism Act 2011, and the evidence provided in the nomination.
