INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT
VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOLS

ROSH PINAH PRIMARY SCHOOL

1. The name of the school is **Rosh Pinah Primary School**.
2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
3. The name of the governing body is **The Governing Body of Rosh Pinah Primary School**.
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) **7 Foundation Governors**.
 - (b) **2 Parent Governors**.
 - (c) **1 LA Governor**.
 - (d) **2 Staff Governors** (including the head teacher and one member of the teaching and support staff).
5. The total number of governors shall be **12** (except at any time when the head teacher has given notice that he/she chooses not to be a governor, when the total number of governors will be **11**).
6. SCOPUS Jewish Educational Trust shall be entitled to appoint Foundation Governors:
 - (a) The School was founded as a JEWISH DAY SCHOOL under the auspices of the SCOPUS Jewish Educational Trust (formerly the Zionist Federation Educational Trust) to provide a balanced secular and Jewish education for children in an environment which complies with orthodox Jewish requirements. The Governing Body will have regard to any representation made to them by SCOPUS relating to the religious curriculum and the teaching of Hebrew as a modern language.
 - (b) The ethos of the School derives from the objective to imbue its pupils with an understanding love and respect for the Jewish religion, a knowledge of Jewish history, both biblical and modern; conversance with Ivrit (the modern Hebrew language); a love of their heritage and respect for Jewish traditional Torah values, especially with regard to the family; and the centrality of biblical and modern Israel as a significant component of a rounded Jewish education.
 - (c) Religious education is provided in accordance with orthodox Jewish teachings from a modern orthodox perspective. Therefore any question as to the belief

and practice of the Jewish faith shall be referred to the Chief Rabbi of the United Hebrew Congregations of the British Commonwealth, whose decision shall be final.

7. The Instrument of Government comes into effect on **31 August 2015**.
8. This Instrument of Government was made by order of the **London Borough of Barnet Local Education Authority** on **6 May 2015**.
9. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the head teacher if not a governor) and the SCOPUS Jewish Educational Trust.

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT FOR COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

MARTIN PRIMARY SCHOOL

1. The name of the school is **Martin Primary School**.
2. The school is a local authority maintained community school.
3. The name of the Governing Body is '**The Governing Body for Martin Primary School**'.
4. The Governing Body shall consist of:
 - a. 6 Co-opted Governors;
 - b. The Headteacher;
 - c. 1 LA Governor;
 - d. 6 Parent Governors;
 - e. 1 Staff Governor.
5. The total number of governors shall be 15.
6. The term of office for Co-opted Governors shall be 2 years.
7. The term of office for LA, Parent and Staff governors shall be 4 years.
8. This Instrument of Government comes into effect on **12 May 2015**.
9. This Instrument of Government was made by order of the **London Borough of Barnet Local Education Authority on2015**.
10. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the Governing Body.
