- 5. The total number of governors shall be 12.

ST MARY'S CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL, LONDON N3

- 1. The name of the school is **St Mary's Church of England Primary School**.
- 2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
- 3. The name of the governing body is: "The governing body of St Mary's Church of England Primary School".
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a. Two elected parent governors;
 - b. One LA governor;
 - c. One staff governor;
 - d. One head teacher (ex-officio)
 - e. Seven foundation governors
- 5. Total number of governors: 12
- 6. The term of office of all governors who are not ex-officio is four years
- 7. Foundation Governors shall be appointed as follows:
 - a. Two appointed by the London Diocesan Board for Schools;
 - b. One appointed by the Parochial Church Council of St Mary-at-Finchley
 - c. One appointed by the Parochial Church Council of St Paul's and St Luke's, Finchley
 - d. One appointed by the Deanery Synod of Central Barnet.
- 8. Holders of the following offices shall be a foundation governor ex-officio:
 - a. The Rector of St Mary-at-Finchley
 - b. The Vicar of St Paul's and St Luke's, Finchley
 - c. The Archdeacon of Hampstead shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of either ex-officio governor whose governorship derives from the offices named in (a) and (b) above, in the event that such ex-officio governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21 of the School Governance (Governance) (England) Regulations 2012 (SI 2012 No. 1034).
- 9. The Archdeacon of Hampstead shall be entitled to request the governing body to remove the ex-officio foundation governors referred to in 8a and 8b above and to appoint any substitute governor
- 10. A Trust Deed exists concerning the school

11. Ethos statement:

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian beliefs and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

HOLY TRINITY C OF E PRIMARY SCHOOL

- 1. The name of the school is "Holy Trinity C of E Primary School"
- 2. The school is a Voluntary Aided school
- 3. The name of the governing body is "The Governing Body of Holy Trinity C of E Primary School"
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a. Two parent governors
 - b. One LA governor
 - c. One staff governor
 - d. One headteacher
 - f. One co-opted governor
 - e. Eight foundation governors
- 5. Total number of governors: **Fourteen**
- 6. The term of office of all elected or appointed governors is 4 years.
- 7. Foundation Governors are appointed as follows:
 - a. Two foundation governor by the London Diocesan Board for Schools
 - b. Two foundation governors by the Central Barnet Deanery Synod
 - c. Three foundation governors by the PCC of Holy Trinity Church, East Finchley
- 8. a. The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio: The Incumbent of Holy Trinity Church, East Finchley
 - b. The Archdeacon of Hampstead shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that that the ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
- 9. The Archdeacon of Hampstead shall be entitled to request the governing body to remove the ex-officio foundation governor referred to in 8a above and to appoint any substitute governor.
- 10. The ethos of the school is:-
 - Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian beliefs and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

- 2. The School was founded by and is part of the Catholic Church. The School is to be conducted as a Catholic School in accordance with Canon Law and the teachings of the Catholic Church, and in accordance with the Trust Deed of the Diocese of Westminster and in particular:
 - (a) religious education is to be in accordance with the teachings, doctrines, discipline and general and particular norms of the Catholic Church;
 - (b) religious worship is to be in accordance with the rites, practices, discipline and liturgical norms of the Catholic Church;

and at all times the School is to serve as a witness to the Catholic faith in Our Lord Jesus Christ.

- 3. The School is a voluntary aided school in the trusteeship of the Archdiocese of Westminster and is an exempt charity for the advancement of the Catholic religion by such means as the Archbishop may think fit.
- 4. The name of the governing body is: The Governing Body of The Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School, Whetstone.
- 5. The Governing Body shall consist of **twelve** governors of which there shall be:
 - (a) seven foundation governors (of whom no more than two shall, at the time of their appointment, be eligible for election or appointment as parent governors);
 - (b) one headteacher governor;
 - (c) two parent governors;
 - (d) one LA governor;
 - (e) one staff governor.
- 6. Foundation governors shall be appointed and may be removed by the Archbishop of Westminster (or any other person exercising Ordinary jurisdiction on his behalf).
- 7. The term of office for every foundation governor shall terminate on **31**st **August** following the third anniversary of the date of appointment.
- 8. This Instrument of Government comes into effect on the date of making.
- 9. This Instrument of Government was approved by the Diocese of Westminster on 14th May 2015 and made by order of Barnet local authority on 28th May 2015.
- 10. A copy of this Instrument of Government must be supplied to every member of the governing body and the Diocese of Westminster.

- 1. The name of the school is **St Catherine's Catholic Primary School, Barnet**.
- 2. The School was founded by and is part of the Catholic Church. The School is to be conducted as a Catholic School in accordance with Canon Law and the teachings of the Catholic Church, and in accordance with the Trust Deed of the Diocese of Westminster and in particular:
 - (a) religious education is to be in accordance with the teachings, doctrines, discipline and general and particular norms of the Catholic Church;
 - (b) religious worship is to be in accordance with the rites, practices, discipline and liturgical norms of the Catholic Church;

and at all times the School is to serve as a witness to the Catholic faith in Our Lord Jesus Christ.

- 3. The School is a voluntary aided school in the trusteeship of the Diocese of Westminster and is an exempt charity for the advancement of the Catholic religion by such means as the Archbishop may think fit.
- 4. The name of the governing body is: The Governing Body of St Catherine's Catholic Primary School, Barnet.
- 5. The Governing Body shall consist of **fourteen** governors of which there shall be:
 - (a) eight foundation governors (of whom no more than two shall, at the time of their appointment, be eligible for election or appointment as parent governors);
 - (b) three parent governors;
 - (c) the headteacher;
 - (d) one LA governor;
 - (e) one staff governor.
- 6. Foundation governors shall be appointed and may be removed by the Archbishop of Westminster (or any other person exercising Ordinary jurisdiction on his behalf).
- 7. The term of office for every foundation governor shall terminate on 31st August following the third anniversary of the date of appointment.
- 8. The terms of office of all other governors shall be four years.
- 9. This Instrument of Government comes into effect on 1st September 2015.
- 10. This Instrument of Government was approved by the Diocese of Westminster on 14th May 2015 and made by order of Barnet local authority on 28th May 2015.
- 11. A copy of this Instrument of Government must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and head teacher if not a governor), and the Diocese of Westminster.
