	The Community Asset Strategy implementation plan, which was agreed by the Assets Regeneration and Growth Committee on 7th September 2015, sets out that the Counci will procure an external agency to develop a methodology and tool that can be used to assess the level of community benefit that VCS organisations in Barnet deliver.					
SUMMARY OF DECISION	The Council ran a competitive quotation process in accordance with Contract Procedure Rules for award of this contract which was authorised by a separate Full Officer DPR in line with the Contract Procedure Rules (Table A). Tender documents were on the Council's procurement portal from 22 nd September- 5 th October. Five bids were received. Simetrica, which received the highest score against quality and price criteria following a scoring and moderation process and will therefore be awarded the contract. Scores are set out in Table 1 below. The scores were assessed based on Quality weighting (60%) and Prince weighting (40%).					
	The value of the contract will be the bid price £33,250 + VAT, which is within the £40,000 limit stated in the tender documents. The contract duration will be until March 2016. Work will be delivered in the 2015/16 financial year. Officer support for contract monitoring will come from the Strategy Unit and the contract will be funded from reserves.					
	The contract will be awarded by the end of October 2015. The tool for assessing community benefit will be developed and piloted before the end of the 2015/16 financial year. The supplier may be required to make adjustments to the tool depending on the outcome of the pilot.					
	Acceptance of contracts must be in accordance with Table A, Contract Procedure Rules and subject to Budget provision; a compliant Procurement process and confirmation of acceptable financial status of the service provider. A separate officer DPR was published at the start of this process to authorise publication of the tender documents. Table A of the Contract Procedure Rules, sets out that the					

	relevant Council Officer as designated in the Scheme of Delegation can accept procedure is with for contracts between £25,001 -£172,514 in value.
	Risks associated with development of the community benefit assessment tool, as well as mitigations, have been identified by Simetrica in their response to tender. These will be monitored throughout contract delivery.
	Once the tool has been developed, an Equalities Impact Assessment will be undertaken.
