The Governing Bodies of the schools listed have submitted details of changes in their Instruments of Government, which is the formal document that outlines the arrangement of each Governing Body.</p>



INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is All Saints' Church of England Primary School.
2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
3. The name of the governing body is "The Governing Body of All Saints' Church of England Primary School".
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a) 2 elected parent governors
 - b) 1 head teacher
 - c) 1 staff governor
 - d) 1 local authority governor
 - e) 7 foundation governors
5. The total number of governors is 12.
6. The name of any foundation body or person entitled to appoint foundation governors is as follows:
 - a) 3 appointed by the PCC of All Saints' Church, Friern Barnet
 - b) 2 appointed by the LDBS
 - c) 1 appointed by the Deanery Synod
7.
 - a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio: the Chief Officiating Minister of All Saints' Church Friern Barnet.
 - b) The Archdeacon of Hampstead shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (7a) above, in the event that that ex-officio governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21 (1) of the Regulations.
 - c) The Archdeacon of Hampstead shall be entitled to request the governing body to remove the ex-officio foundation governor referred to in 7a above and appoint any substitute governor.
8. The number of governors who have a child enrolled at the school must not exceed five.
9. A trust exists.
10. Ethos statement:

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level. The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian beliefs and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

11. The term of office for all governors is four years, excepting the head-teacher and the Chief Officiating Minister at All Saints' Church.
12. This instrument of government comes into effect on 30th April 2015.
13. The instrument was made by order of Barnet Local Authority on 21st September 2015.
14. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and head teacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the London Diocesan Board for Schools.
