Appendix B – Response to Question 60

What was the size of the central government's Revenue Support Grant to Barnet Council in the financial years a) 2010-2011 and b) 2014-15?

Comparison of Revenue Support Grant in isolation does not show the whole picture as funding allocation has changed over the last 5 years. RSG is now the main form of central government grant support, however in 2010/11 central government grant support comprised of: Area based grant, Revenue support grant, contribution from NNDR pool and other core grants. Business rates retention scheme now means that we retain our business rates and are paid a top up. In order to assess the difference in funding between the years, we need to include NNDR in 2015/16 figures and exclude Public Health, New Homes Bonus and Council Tax Support from 2015/16 figures. The impact of this is:
