INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT MENORAH HIGH SCHOOL FOR GIRLS

- 1. The name of the school is Menorah High School for Girls (the "School").
- 2. The school is a voluntary aided school. The foundation of the school is the Menorah High School for Girls Foundation Trust (company number 06288755, registered charity number 1119847) a charitable company limited by guarantee (the "Foundation").
- 3. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of the Menorah High School" (the "Governing Body").
- 4. The Governing Body shall consist of:
 - a. 2 parent governors;
 - b. 1 local authority governor;
 - c. 1 staff governor;
 - d. 1 headteacher (unless the headteacher resigns the office of governor by giving written notice to the clerk); and
 - e. 7 foundation governors.
- 5. Total number of governors 12 (or 11 in the event that the headteacher resigns the office of governor).
- 6. The headteacher is an ex officio governor. The term of office of:
 - a. any parent governor is two years;
 - b. [the local authority governor is [four] years];
 - c. the staff governor is two years; and
 - d. foundation governors shall be between one year and four years as determined by the Foundation at the time of appointment and notified to the clerk.
- 7. The Foundation is entitled to appoint the foundation governors.
- 8. The School's religious ethos is to provide a strictly orthodox Jewish environment that demonstrates a commitment to Torah values.
- 9. This instrument of government comes into effect on the date of its making.
- 10. This instrument was made by order of the London Borough of Barnet on 26th January 2016.
- 11. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governor body (and the headteacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.
