Variation to an Eruv Licence at Woodside Park	28/06/17	Strategic Director for Environment	This report seeks authorisation to enter into a Variation of Licence with Woodside Park Eruv Committee. It intends to vary the terms of the Eruv Licence between The London Borough of Barnet (1) and Woodside Park Eruv Committee (2) dated 14 July 2014. The alternative option of not having a licence in place would have created unacceptable risks for residents, road users and the Council. The option of having a Licence in place provides for appropriate insurance to be procured by the licensee and contains provisions designed to regulate the maintenance of the Eruv equipment. To amend the 2014 Licence to include two additional sites at Partridge Lane, NW7 in accordance with the Planning Permission and Drawings. The Licence authorised the erection and retention of various apparatus and poles on or at various positions on the public highway, to facilitate the construction and retention of an Eruv, on the terms contained in the Licence pursuant to the enabling planning permissions referred to in the Licence. This report relates to a previous Eruv licence, which was issued to the Trustees of the Woodside Park Eruv Committee. A decision has been made to authorise a variation to this licence.
