Background: Camden is proposing closure of Briardale Gardens to traffic from the Finchley Road. According to Camden's traffic survey there are approximately **450 vehicles per hour** during the morning rush hour using Briardale Gardens. Closure would mean this traffic will most likely be displaced into neighbouring streets.

Petition wording:

We the undersigned petition the council to Object to Camden's plans to make Briardale Gdns No Entry from the Finchley Rd. This will inevitably move the traffic volumes from Briardale Gdns to other local roads both in Barnet and Camden. We the undersigned object to the transfer of the Briardale traffic onto our roads and reject the No Entry proposal. A fairer proposal has to be developed that recognises the interests of all local roads.

This petition was originated by Councillor Peter Zinkin and Councillor Shimon Ryde.
