SUMMARY OF DECISION	This report seeks approval to award two contracts for the supply of digital magazines and online newspapers for use by Barnet Libraries customers to W. F. Howes.					
	Background					
	Barnet Libraries provide a range of online magazines and newspapers for use by customers of Barnet Libraries. These form part of the digital offer for online resources providing free access to members of dictionaries, encyclopaedias, biographies, family history and research resources as well as online support for life skills such as driving theory test and citizenship test, job hunting and learning languages. In addition, a large collection of eBooks and eAudiobooks are available for customers to download. An ITQ was advertised on the Council's electronic e-sourcing portal on the 12 January 2018 for 20 days. 9 suppliers registered their interest in this ITQ and five bids were received for 3 lots.

	The first contract is for lot 1, digital magazines with W.F. Howes. The contract commencement date is 1 May 2018 to 30 April 2020, with an option to extend for a further fixed-term period of up to two years from 1 May 2020 to 30 April 2022. The total value of this contract award (including the extension option) is £27,796.
