I request that the CES Committee receives a report on use of supported accommodation for care leavers, including data for the last two years on:

- How many Barnet care leavers are in such accommodation, and where they are located?
- How often is such accommodation inspected and what is the inspection regime?
- How many young people have we moved between such accommodation?
- How do we know from other boroughs what other young people are there?
- Is the accommodation mixed or single gender?
- What steps are taken to make sure young people from opposing gangs are not housed together?
- What is the criteria for young people being housed in this way?
- What are the other options?
- How long do these placements last for?

I also request that the Committee receives this report on a regular 6 monthly basis going forward.
