**OBJECTION FOR A NEW PREMISES LICENCE**

Applicant Ales Licencing Services on behalf of Hydamin Ltd  
Premises: Nez. 418C Watford Way NW7 2QJ ("the Premises")

I am writing to register my objection to the application for a premises licence by Nez. 418C Watford Way, Mill Hill, London, NW7 2QJ. The basis for this opposition is that granting a licence for these premises will not promote the licencing objectives, particularly the prevention of crime, disorder and antisocial behaviour.

The applicant proposes to allow:

- A) The provision of late night refreshment (indoor only) from 23.00 hours until 05.00 hours Monday -- Sunday.
- B) Sale or supply of alcohol (both on and off the premises) from 08.00 hours until 00.00 hours Monday -- Sunday.

Granting a licence would provide a further source of alcohol within an area already so heavily populated with licenced premises, there are already 10 premises which have obtained a license within a 1-mile radius. Resulting in crime, disorder and public nuisance which have already reached problematic levels for the local police.

Residents in this area already suffer noise nuisance and antisocial behaviour at all hours of the day and night. They have endured this inconvenience since 2003 when the licensing legislation was first amended, and it is totally unacceptable to expect them to continue to do so.

There are also two schools which are a short distance away from this premises, both girl's schools have to pass this premises to on their daily commute, to catch a bus which is also followed by walking beneath the underpass on five-ways corner in order to catch the bus on the other side of the road going towards Edgware. I am really concerned that there could be a high possibility that alcoholics will gather under the underpass on a daily basis which ultimately affects the safety of these pupil and other individuals. In addition to this, the increase of alcohol sales will unquestionably lead to an increase into broken glass along the pedestrian paths which poses a significant hazard to the members of the public and not to mention possible nuisances during the night affecting the local neighbourhood.

In view of the above, I would urge the Licensing Authority to refuse this application.

I am writing to register my objection to the application for a premises licence to sell Off License, by Hydamin Ltd of 418C Watford Way NW7 2QJ.

The basis of this opposition is that granting a license to another premises on the small parade with the permission to sell alcohol and spirits will not meet the objectives of licensing, in particular the prevention of crime, disorder and anti-social behaviour.

The Premises hereunder is situated within the Barnet Council's Cumulative Area and enabling the premises to sell alcohol would be totally detrimental to its aims and objectives.

**The applicant proposes to allow:**

**A) The provision of late-night refreshment (indoor only) from 23.00 hours until 05.00 hours Monday - Sunday.**

**B) Sale or supply of alcohol (both on and off the Premises) from 08.00 hours until 00.00 hours Monday - Sunday.**

Granting such a license would provide a further source of alcohol within an area already heavily populated with licensed premises, there are already 10 premises which obtain a premises license within a 1-mile radius; which has already caused alarm due to the crime, disorder and public nuisances that have already reached problematic levels for the local Police Authorities, who are already overstretched.

Residents in this area mainly consist of professional and retired members of the community, the occurrence of more local premises' licenses being granted would jeopardise their enjoyment of a peaceful local community and ultimately their safety.

My main concern is that there are a high number of properties that are LET by rooms in the surrounding area (Page Street NW7, Great Northway NW4 and Hall lane NW4), which are occupied by single males whom tend to have alcohol related problems. There will be an easy access to the source of alcohol during the night/day if this licence is granted to this premises.

Also, this property is located on the corner of five ways corner, which has residential flats located above, granting the premises licence will ultimately result into a significant amount of noise nuisance and litter which will be experienced by the tenants.

In addition, residents in this area already suffer noise nuisance and antisocial behaviour at all hours of the day and night. They have endured this inconvenience since 2003 when the licensing legislation was first amended, and it is totally unacceptable to expect them to continue to do so.

There is also two schools which are of a short distance away from this premises that will result into problems occurring if a license is permitted due to, both girl schools have to pass this premises to on their daily commute leading them to catch a bus which is also followed by walking beneath the underpass on five-ways corner in order to catch the bus on the other side of the road going towards Edgware. I am really concerned that there could be a high possibility that alcoholics which will gather under the underpass on a daily basis which ultimately affect the safety of these individuals. 

The application for the sale or supply of alcohol from 08.00 to 00.00 hours Monday to Sunday is also completely inappropriate.

~~There is already a licensed premises on this very small parade of shops on the Watford Way which has been serving the community for many decades. A second licensed premises is not warranted nor required.~~

The surrounding area is residential.

There are two senior schools within walking distance of the small parade of shops. A further licensed premises within such close proximity to schools is inappropriate.

Also within walking distance is the Allianz Park Rugby Club, and the Cophall Leisure Centre.

Sunnyhill Park is also within close proximity and of course is open 24/7.

The area surrounding the parade of shops is quiet and frequented mostly by local residents, school pupils, rugby fans and those in the community visiting the leisure centre. There is no requirement for a 24 hour licensed premises which is new to the area and wishing to promote the sale of alcohol.

If the above application is granted, it would make alcohol more readily available for longer periods of time and inevitably fuel more violence in the surrounding residential area, with the risk of potential break-ins and anti-social behaviour, resulting in Police attendances.

Please do not grant this license.
