Mr David Bennett	11	<p>Can the Finchley & Golders Green Area committee confirm that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • it is satisfied that the proposals set out in SCR424 are in the best interests of local residents; and • that the Consultation was effective and sufficient, including that all feedback provided by local residents up to and including Friday 21.01.22 was forwarded to the scheme owner and included in the Chief Officer Decision report which was reviewed by the Executive Director for Environment, with the outcome summarised in the agenda, circulated on Friday 21.01.22. 	<p>The results of the feasibility study to review the Hampstead Way/Meadway junction was tabled at the 30 June 2022, F&GG Area Committee. Having considered the report, the Committee voted to approve option 2 of the officer recommendation which included a statutory consultation.</p> <p>The consultation is a statutory process to determine resident feedback on the proposals being considered for implementation. It is normal for a statutory consultation to be open for 3 weeks however, during holiday periods the timescale maybe extended to 4 weeks to ensure maximum resident feedback. Following the concerns raised by yourself and your dialogue with Jackie, she has arranged for your feedback to be included in the Chief Officer Decision (COD). I have been made aware that the feedback received throughout the consultation period is currently being reviewed, and will be included in the COD for Executive Director of Environment consideration.</p> <p>The summarised ‘Road Safety Scheme’ item for this location is the summary of work remaining to progress the scheme. For clarity, the scheme will not be implemented until the COD has been produced, reviewed and discussed with the Executive Director.</p>

Mr David Bennett	<p>Agenda Item 11 – Scheme Update Road Safety & Parking</p> <p>Consultation SCR424 attempts to deal with pedestrian safety and speeding cars at the junction of Hampstead Way and Meadway, but the Council's own analysis is clear that these are not problems, so the Council has adopted a proposal (according to the agenda) which solves a problem that doesn't exist with a solution that will cause significant inconvenience to the local residents, based on a consultation which was flawed because: no letter was served on local residents; the notice did not contain accurate details of the proposal; and the Council failed to provide any detailed response to multiple questions till 13.01.22 when the consultation was closed.</p>
