The contract commenced on 3rd December 2018 for an initial period of 3 years with the option to extend for a further 2 years, until 2nd December 2023.

Top up funding to be sourced from Think Ahead residual monies. The second OT post would replace the vacant OT Assistant Post which has not been possible to fill to date.

This payment supports the delivery of a 3 month Winter Wellness Project aimed at supporting wider health and social care services by preventing/reducing requests for key service and/or supporting people to move more efficiently between services. The funding will be used to support older adults to improve their mobility; reduce social isolation; improve their digital connectedness; provide them with information and advice about services that are available to them and provide them with access to a handyperson service. The additional funding has been made available by the Contain Outbreak Management Fund (COMF).
