6 b)	Petition: Decoy Avenue Road Safety	A Road Safety & Parking request was raised by Cllr Cohen, this has been approved and officers will programme the speed survey which includes point of origin/destination to track vehicle movement.
6 c)	Petition: Hervey Close	A Road Safety & Parking request was raised by Cllr Houston, this has been approved and officers will programme the speed survey which includes point of origin/destination to track vehicle movement.
7 a)	Issue: Traffic Castle Road	Officers confirm further to our response a Road Safety & Parking scheme has been approved to review the concerns raised in this location. The surveys will be programmed by Highway Engineers in September when schools return to ensure the full impact of the issues faced are captured in the results. The presentation provided at committee will be shared with the scheme owner for their information.
