Opposition Motion in the name of Cllr Dan Thomas

<u>Council commits to not joining neighbouring Labour-controlled Camden Council in</u> restricting all council-operated roads to a 20mph speed limit

Council notes that:

1. All of the roads operated by our neighbouring London Borough of Camden are set at 20mph

Council believes that:

- 1. Varied speed limits are required for convenient travel around a borough as large and populated as Barnet
- 2. Inner London boroughs are more compact and have different traffic flow and journey trends than Outer London boroughs
- 3. 20mph zones can serve a good purpose in certain localities, for example, outside schools.
- 4. Arbitrary speed limits should never be imposed.

Council resolves to:

1. Commit to not making the whole of Barnet a '20mph borough'
