

Council meeting, 1 November 2022

Amendment to Opposition Motion in the name of Cllr Daniel Thomas: Cllr Alan Schneiderman

Council will not raise the price of Garden Waste from £70 collections for the remainder of the administration to help with the cost-of-living crisis.

Delete all and replace with [amendments in bold]:

Council notes that:

1. Residents across the borough are suffering from a cost-of-living crisis **caused by this Conservative Government.**
2. The London Borough of Barnet currently charges £70 a year for garden waste collections – **a charge brought in by the Barnet Conservatives.**
3. **The Barnet Conservatives planned to increase this charge to £80 when they ran the Council.**

Council believes that:

1. It would be wrong to increase the price of the garden waste collection service **as proposed by the Conservatives** when so many in Barnet are suffering from the increasing costs of living.

Council resolves to:

1. Not to proceed with the rise in the price of the garden waste collection service **as proposed by the Barnet Conservatives.**
