Aerial Photography for Great Britain Member  
Licence (APGB)

To sign the national Aerial Photography for Great  
Britain (APGB) Member Licence.

The council previously agreed to and signed the  
APGB Member Licence in March 2019 following a  
Chief Officer Decision by the Director of Assurance  
in February 2019.

Since this date there have been extensions to the  
APGB agreement which currently ends in March  
2024. It is possible that the APGB will be further  
renewed or extended.

There have been some minor variations to the  
Member Licence including perpetual rights for  
some existing data products and recognition of a  
new supplier platform. Due to these changes the  
council is required to re-sign the APGB Member  
Licence.
