Update February 2013

- Higher quality and safer services
- Implementation plans on track to deliver November 2013
- Building works underway
- Clinical Cabinet conducted Deep Dives into all clinical workstreams
- Workforce detail complete
- Clinical workstreams – Emergency care, maternity and neonates, paediatrics and planned care; implementation plans; constant review of activity and plans
- Urgent care centre being piloted at Barnet Hospital A&E





Planning in relation to– Looking Ambulance Services back

2007

- LAS part of membership of original project Board and strategy business case development

2008

- Independent Review Panel – LAS gave evidence to the panel

2010

- BEH Clinical review of evidence (2007-10)
- Examples from Stroke and heart attacks that diversion can result in better outcomes for patients
- The panel heard that currently take 44 patients a day to Emergency Department at Chase Farm
- Majority taken to Chase Farm are picked up around the A10 corridor
- LAS continue to take planned care patients to Chase Farm

2010

- Transport group recommendation:-
- Take a more holistic approach to travel strategy

2012

- Both Barnet and Chase Farm Hospitals NHS Trusts and North Middlesex University Hospital NHS Trust's Full Business Cases for capital investment modelled A&E attendances and impact on LAS.

2013

- LAS and commissioners capacity modelling in 2012/13
- Changes planned for BEH is one of core assumptions for that modelling
- Incorporated learning from changes that were delivered safely at Queen Marys in Sidcup in November 2010



Average LAS Attendance at Hospitals

- Barnet Hospital 57
- Chase Farm Hospital 40
- North Middlesex Hospital 82

Barnet PCT Daily Average

- 112 incidents a day
- 40 Immediately life threatening
- 7 Blue lighted in to hospital



April-2012 to January-2013

- Total of **26,245** incidents conveyed in Enfield PCT
 - **11,142 (42.5%)** to Chase Farm Emergency Department
- Total of **27,264** incidents conveyed in Barnet PCT
 - **14,897 (54.6%)** going to Barnet Emergency Department
