	We had requested a mirror to be placed on Marsh Hill but was advised by Highways Officer this was not possible.	
	Title: Faded yellow line - Island/roundabout at the bottom of East View Resident: Sam Bowers	After receiving the chaser in January, we checked with Highways to see if the line was removed during resurfacing and have received confirmation that no works have taken place.
2.	Ward: I wonder if you could please look at re-painting the yellow line around the island/roundabout at the bottom of East View. It was not re-painted properly when the road was resurfaced. Cars now park around the island blocking access for me to drive safely off of my driveway.	We have therefore flagged the location to our maintenance team for relining. However, we cannot give a definitive date for when the works will be carried out. The team are working through a backlog following a period of inactivity last year.
	This also blocks access for lorries if people are parked in the residential parking spaces outside. Which they always are.	
	The residents are paying hundreds of pounds per household to park outside their own homes and now random people come and park here for free causing a danger to our safely parked cars and blocking access to driveways.

There is provision for 4 parked cars in a series of marked-out bays on the One option would be to convert these spaces into a pavement and cars on the kerb as they do on the rest of Dollis Road on the hill towards Find Tube station or remove parking all together. A further solution would be calming measures - either a single lane chicane or a series of sleeping p the very least a speed camera with high visibility signage should be ered motorists from speeding. In addition, to provide safe access to our proper request a pedestrian crossing to be installed in front our houses, ideally crossing (with traffic lights), or at least a Zebra Crossing and remove so parking to provide better visibility to pedestrians and drivers.
