The unit has double in since September 2022. However, during Covid their finances were depleted, and the unit had to replace a number of items after the pandemic which were out of date. This has resulted in the unit not having the finances to purchase the badges to award to their members to celebrate their efforts.  The unit currently has approximately 30 members. Who could each receive 42 badges to bring them up to date with their work done to date. The badges cost 60p each. There are also additional event and anniversary badges. It would cost approximately £25.20/head.

Assistance in purchasing the badges would encourage the members to complete their badge work to mark the achievement of 70 years of the unit next year.

Rainbows is for girls 4-7 years old and Brownies for girls 7 -10 years old.

As part of the wider Girl Guiding movement the 7<sup>th</sup> Barnet Brownies supports girls to 'laugh, learn, explore and have adventures. Girl Guiding was established to build a more equal world for girls where they would have the same opportunities as boys.

The movement builds confidence in girls where they have a collective voice – with girls, led by girls – building the next generation of strong women.

This application would have the community benefit of supporting this long-established Brownie Unit to move into their 70<sup>th</sup> year building on their success.

The promise made by all members of the guiding movement is to be an active citizen of the community and wider world, to help others and develop her spiritual side whatever she believes. These aims match those of community funding to help build a stronger and more engaged local community.
