


In addition to the survey, respondents were also provided with an opportunity to add any further comments using an interactive map. This allowed them to point specifically at a problem area and to add their comments.



"I am an elderly tenant who makes frequent trips to hospital. I am reliant on my visitors to help me with everyday tasks i.e. shopping, paying bills, odd jobs like changing light bulb. If my visitors had to pay for parking or were limited as to when they could come I would be without the essential daily help that I am dependent on".

"The parking is absolutely horrible - we often either have to wait for long, or park long way away from home! VVVV bad. Please help!"

"I live in a cul-de-sac and therefore cannot have my own driveway or dropped kerb. If you introduce a parking permit scheme then I will be disadvantaged with neighbours in who have their own driveways. This will impact me and my visiting family hugely and it is unreasonable and unfair".
