Barnet Homes

"Barnet Homes is in favour of a CPZ that encompass the land that we manage for a number of reasons as shown below:"

- *Access issues where cars are parked on both sides of the road.*
- *Abandoned vehicles taking up spaces which reduces the parking for residents.*
- *Damage to grass verges or lawned areas by inconsiderate parking.*
