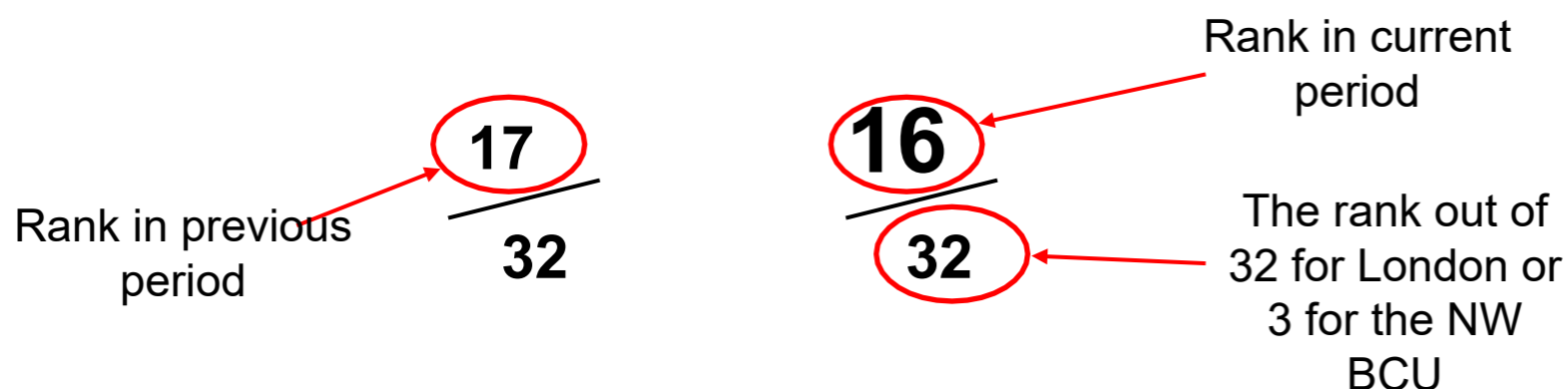

Notes Before We Start

- The lower the ranking the better Barnet is doing when compared with other boroughs across London on in the North West Borough Command Unit (NW BCU).



- Knife crime has previously been reported on as under 25s and non-DV only, this report will note all knife crime with injury which will give a higher number than previous.
- In the London comparison 1/32 is the best, 32/32 is the worst. Change is indicated by the Red Amber Green circle.
- In the NW BCS comparison 1/3 is the best, 3/3 is the worst. Change is indicated by the Red Amber Green arrow.
- Please note that certain graphs in this presentation are weighted by the number of population to make the numbers comparable with other boroughs, when this is the case, the graph will be titled appropriately.

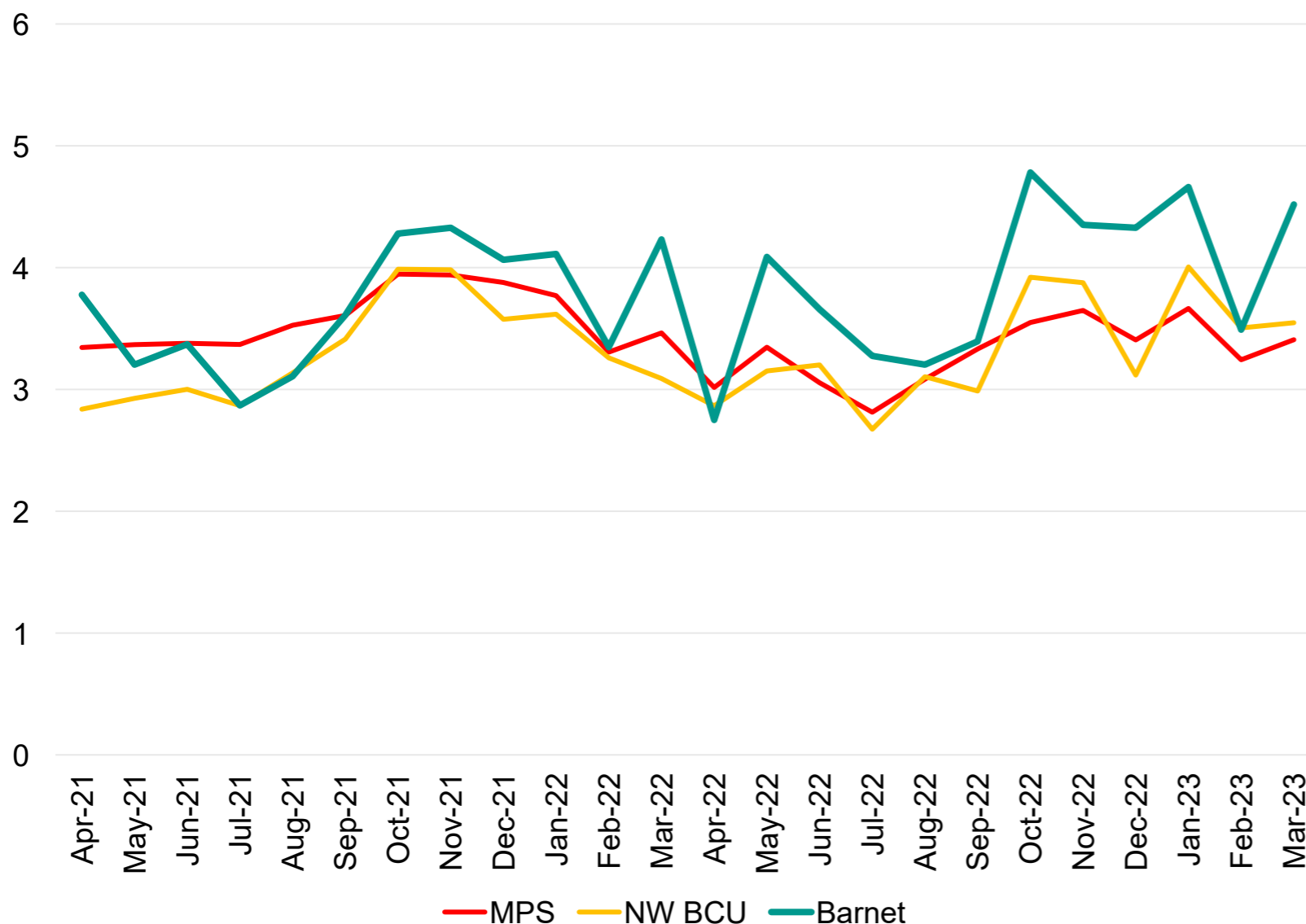
Domestic Burglary



In the 12 months up to March 2023, there were 1945 cases of Residential Burglary in Barnet.

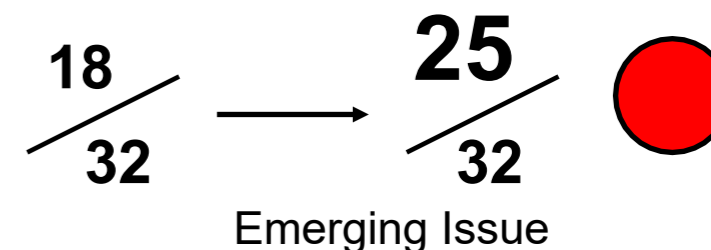
Trend

Residential Burglary per 10,000 Population

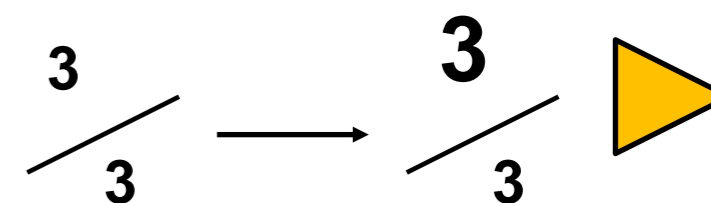

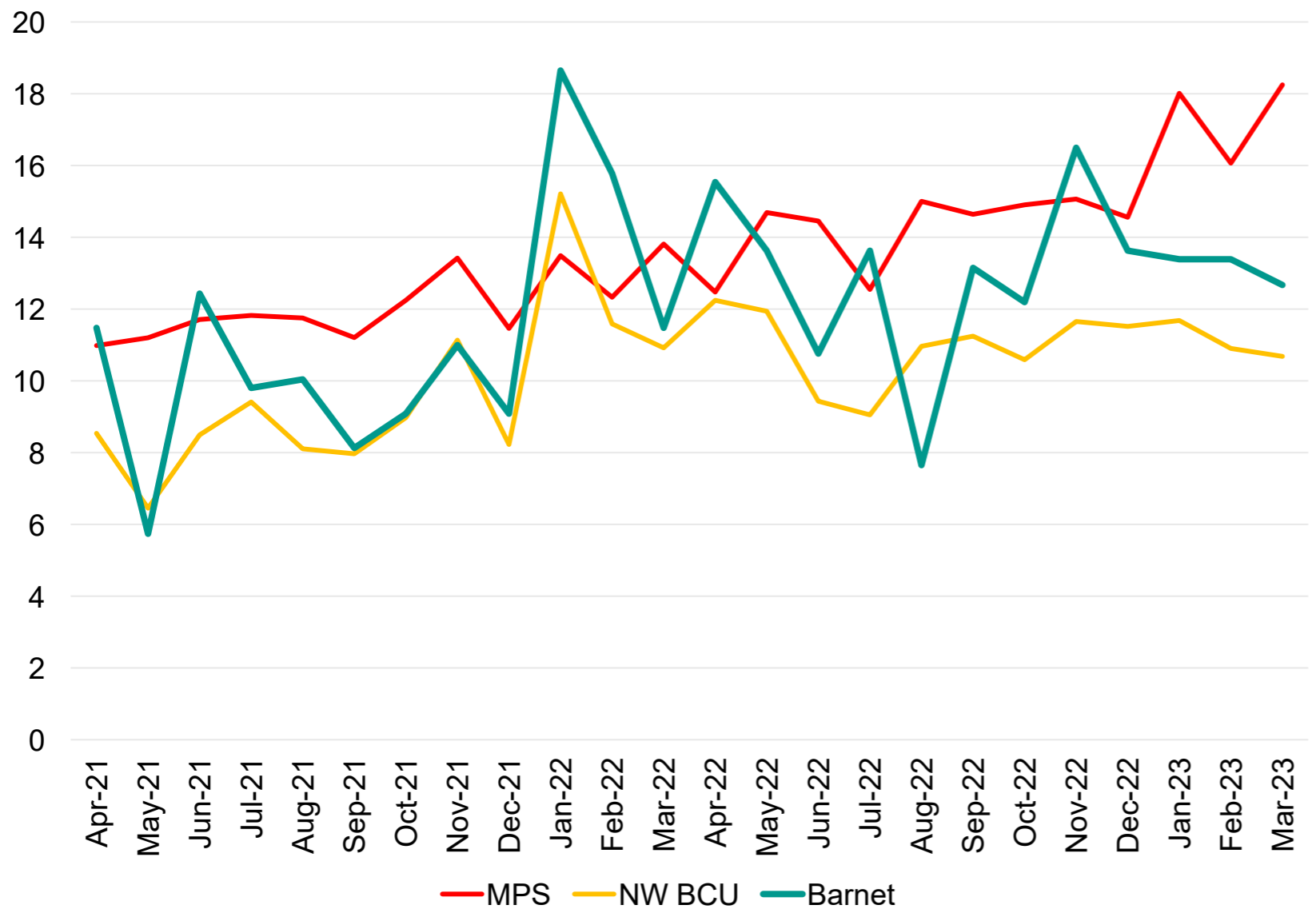
Burglary Business and Community

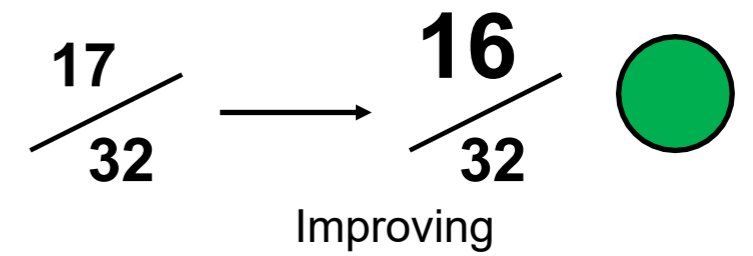

Non-Residential Burglary per 100,000 Population

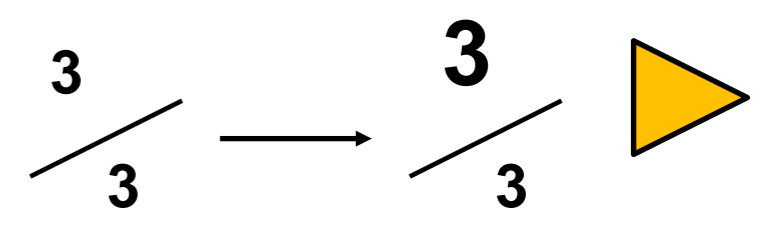

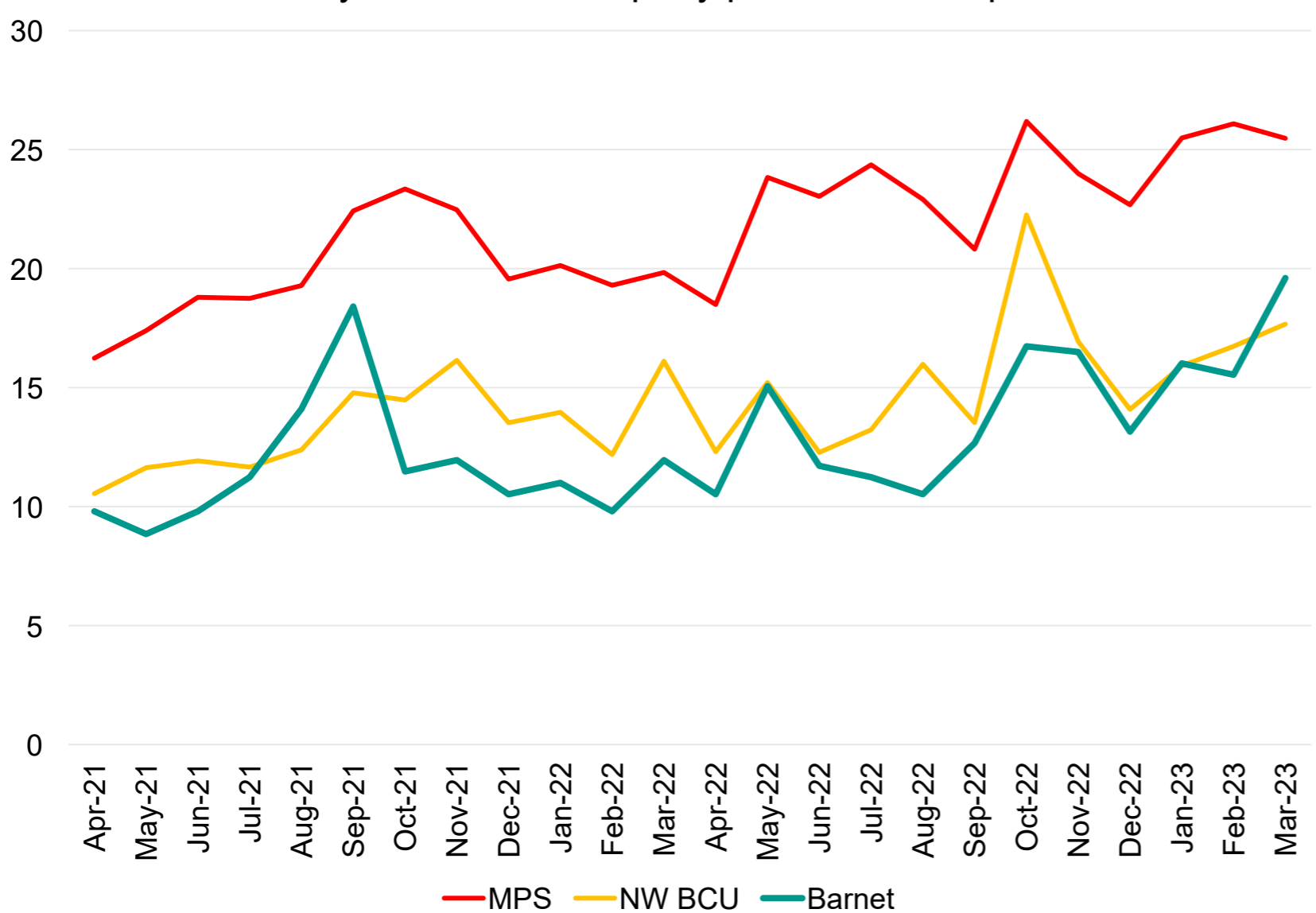
Robbery of Personal Property

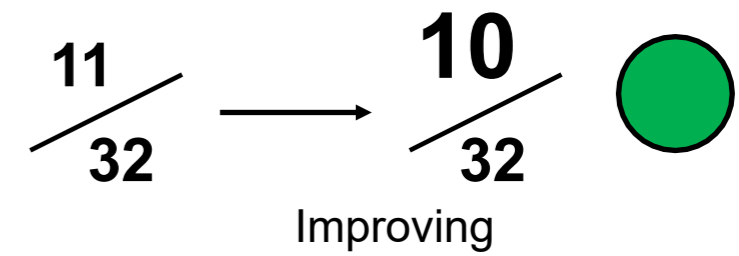
Trend

Robbery of Personal Property per 100,000 Population

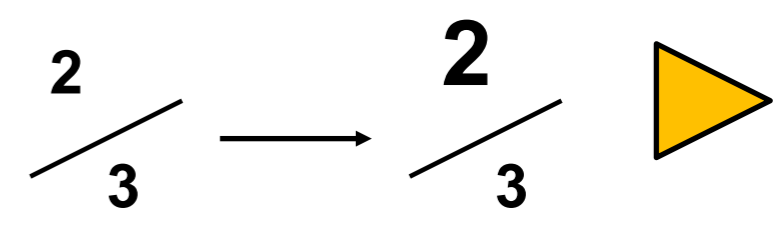

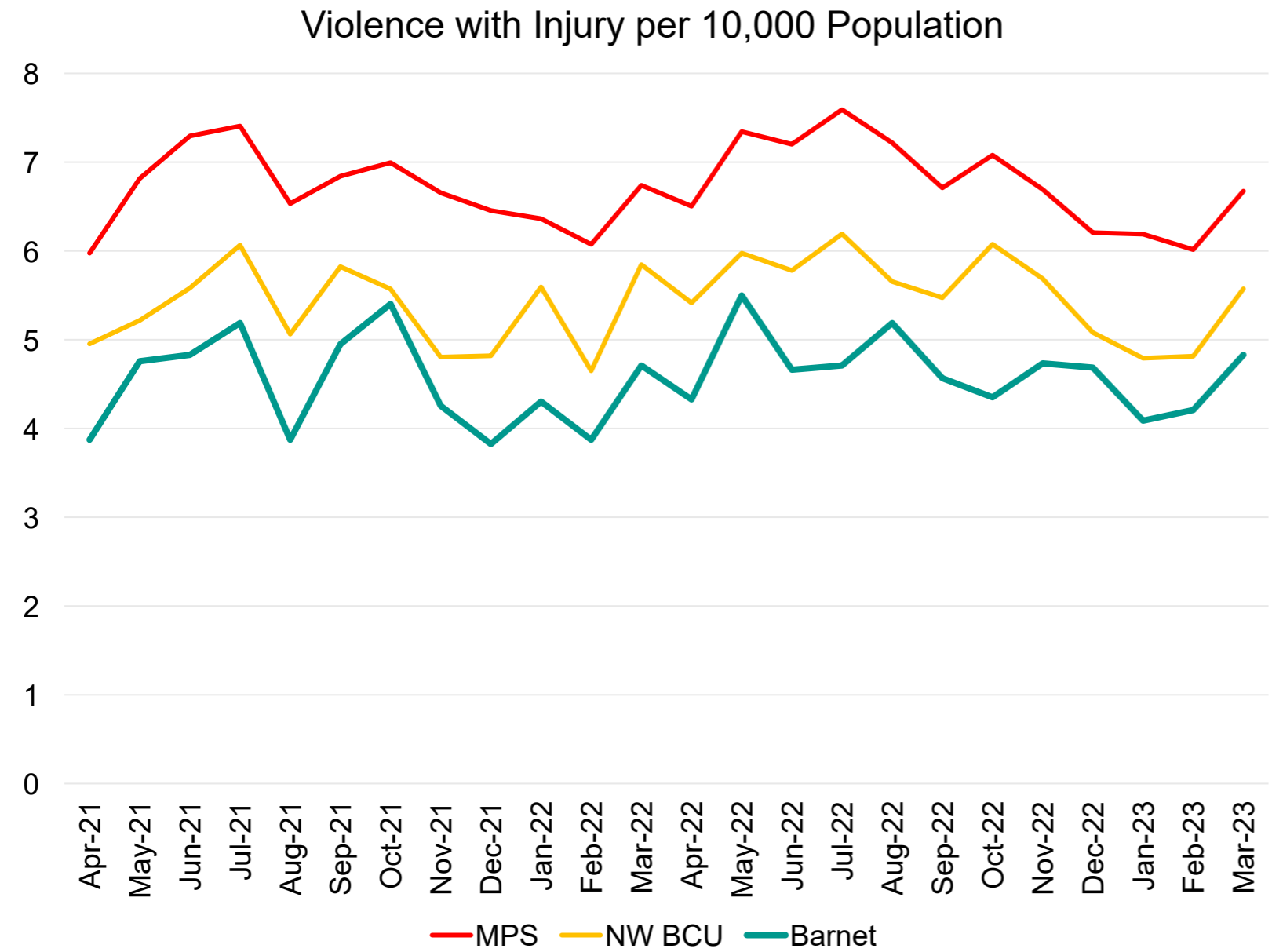

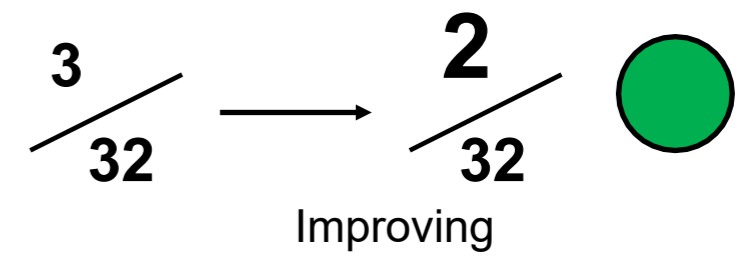

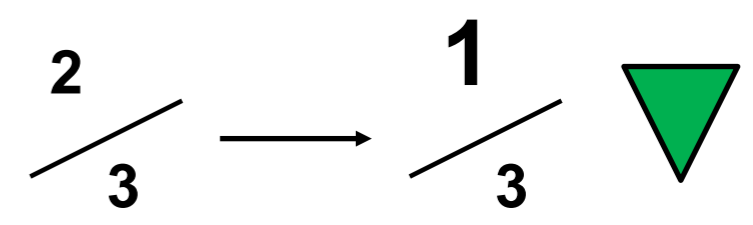

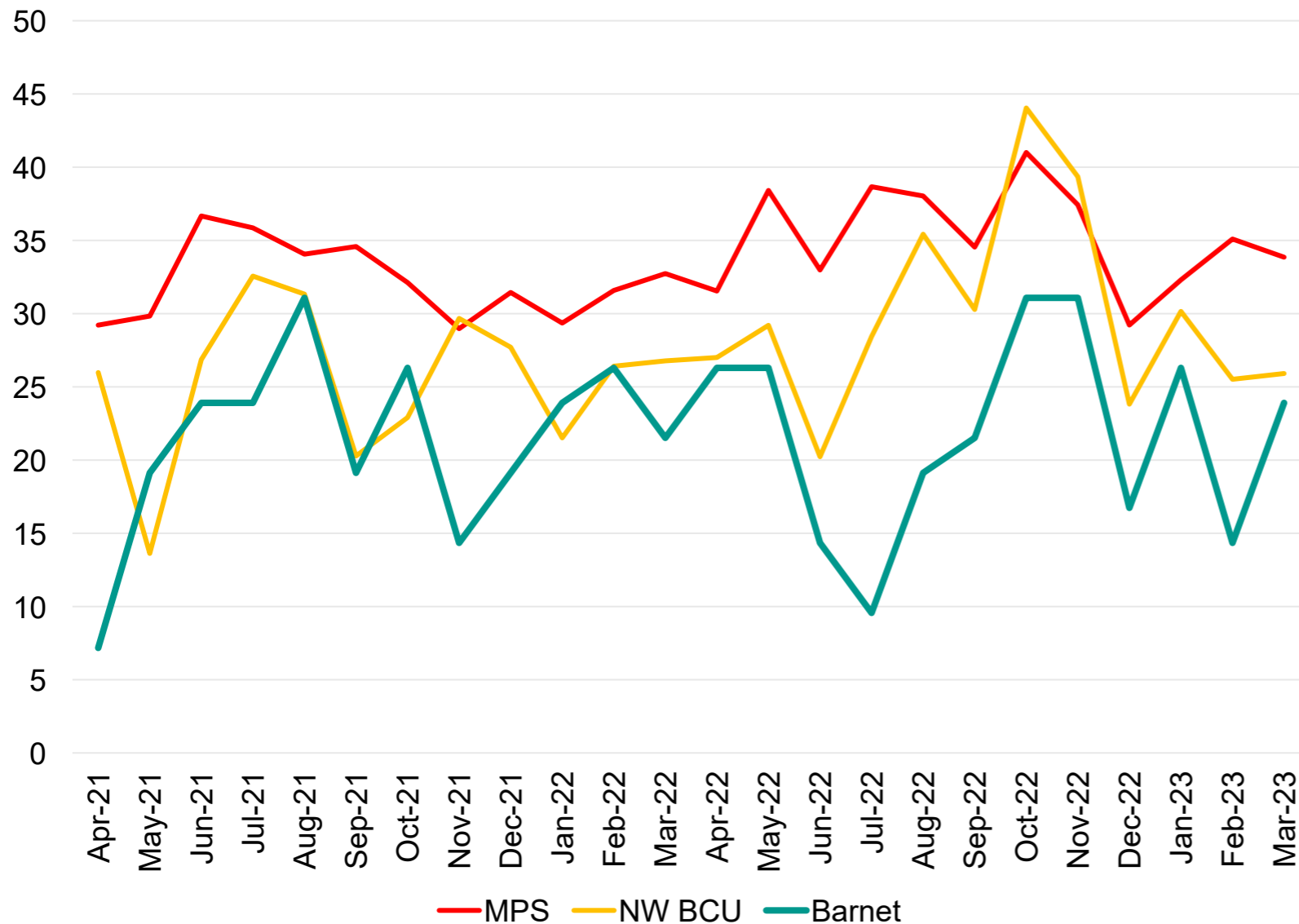
Knife Crime With Injury

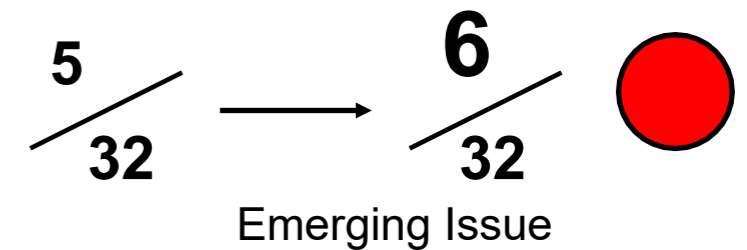

Knife Crime With Injury per 1,000,000 Population

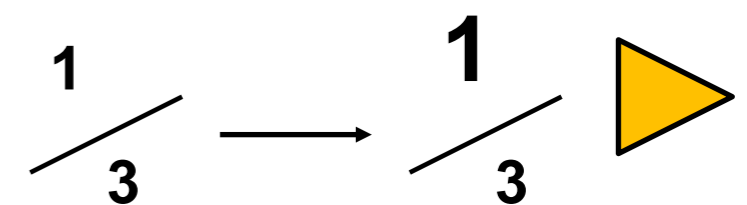

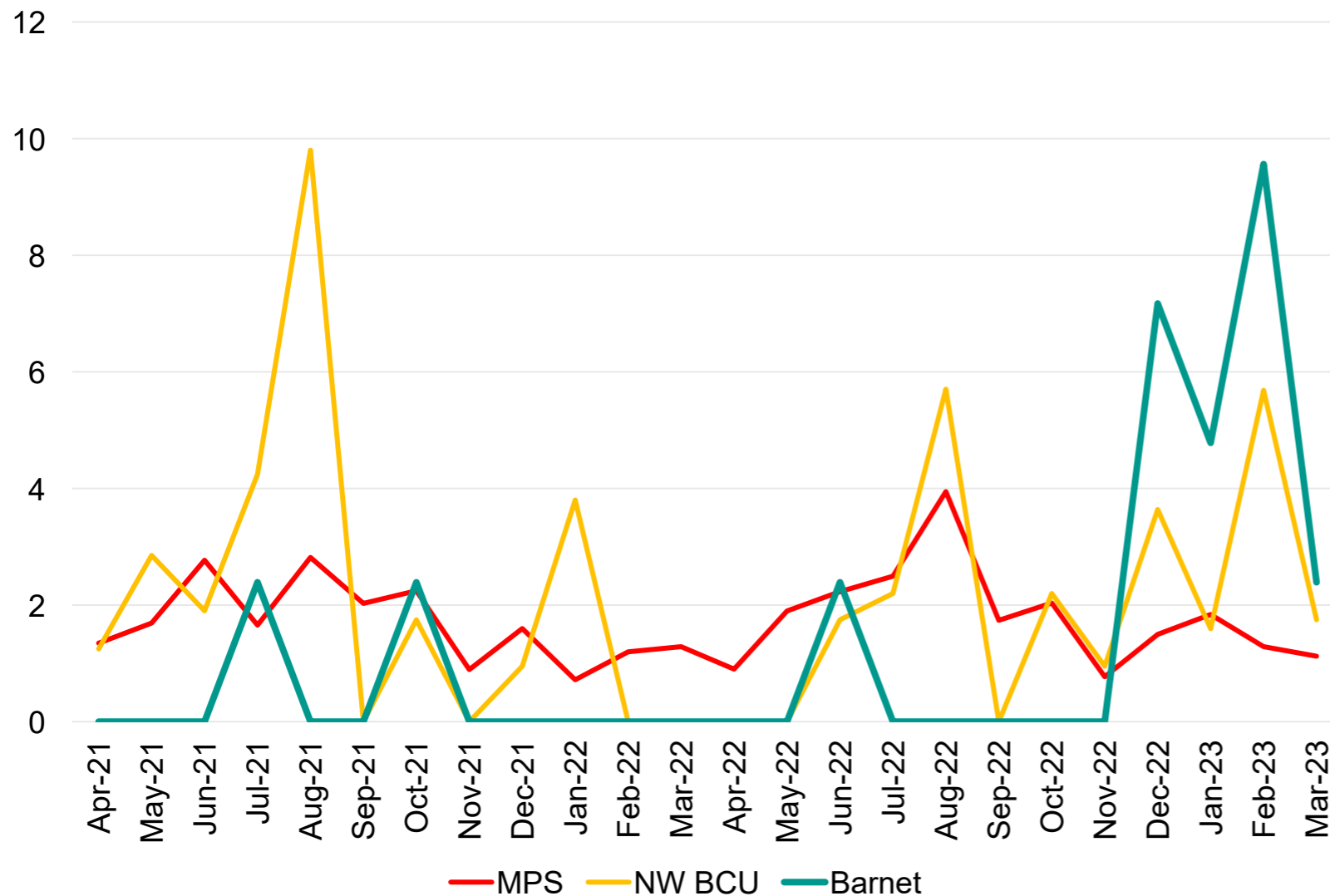
Gun Crime Lethal Barrelled Discharged

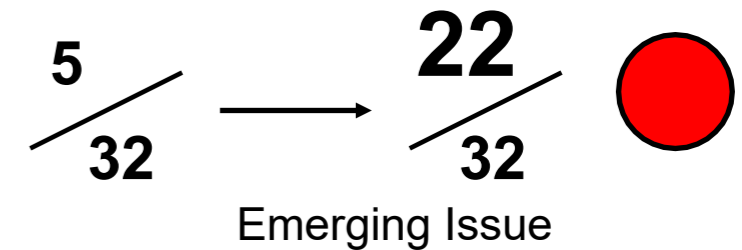

Gun Crime Lethal Barrelled Discharged per 1,000,000 Population

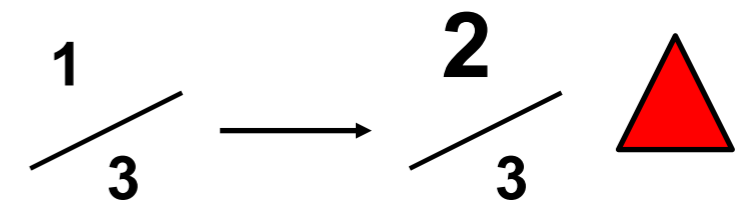

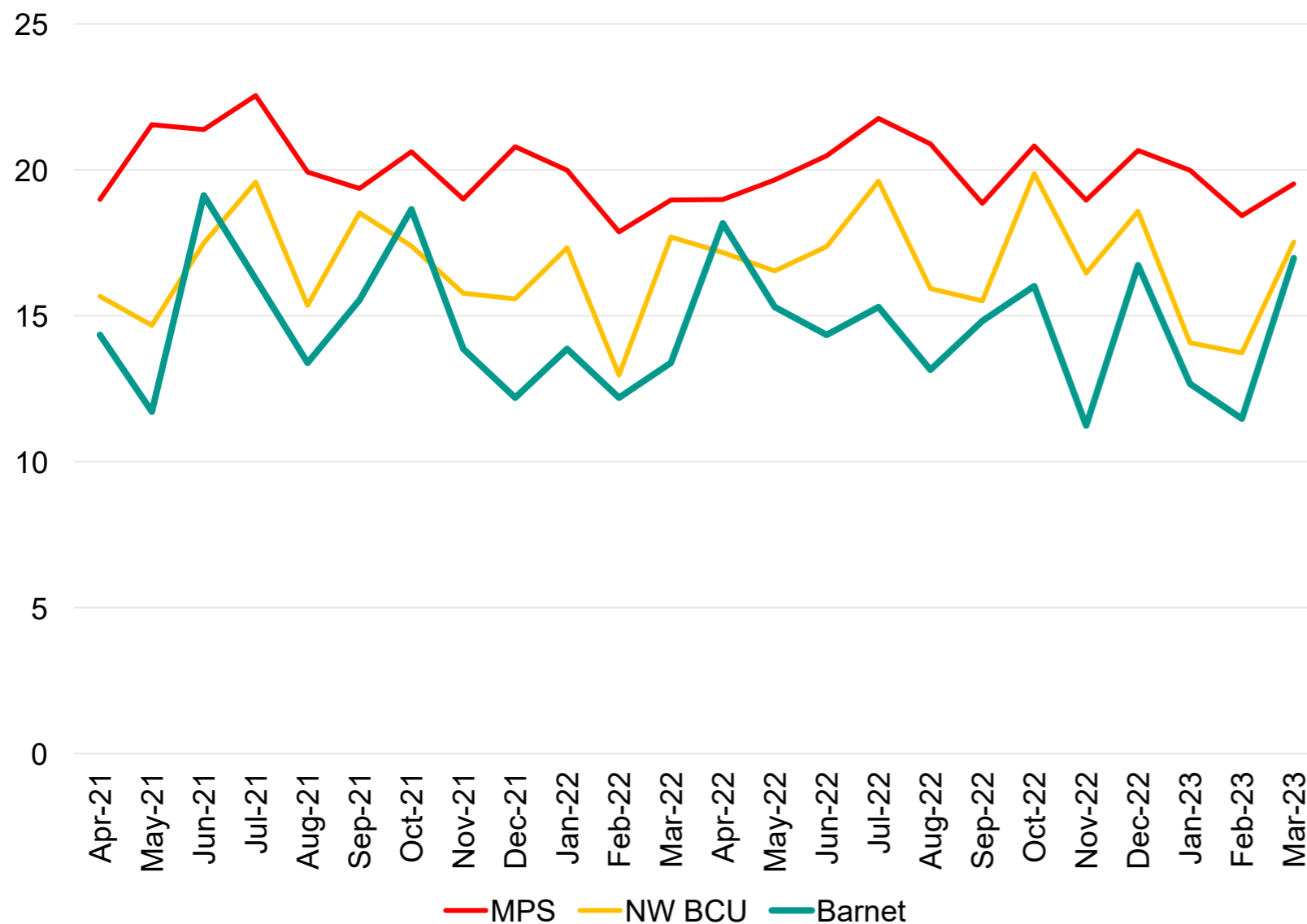
Domestic Abuse VWI

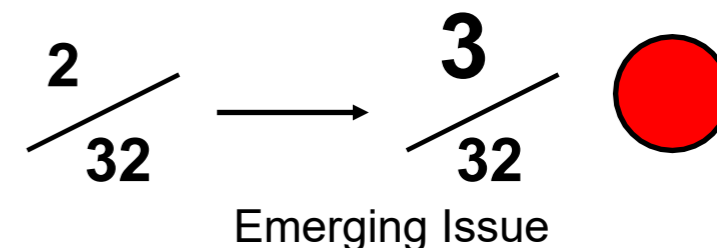

Domestic Abuse VWI per 100,000 Population

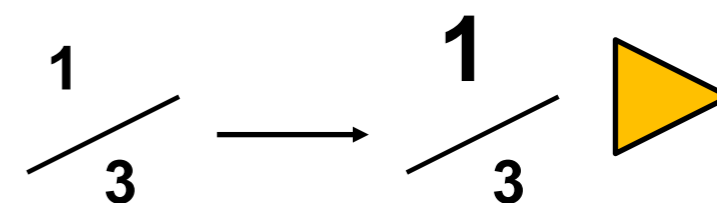

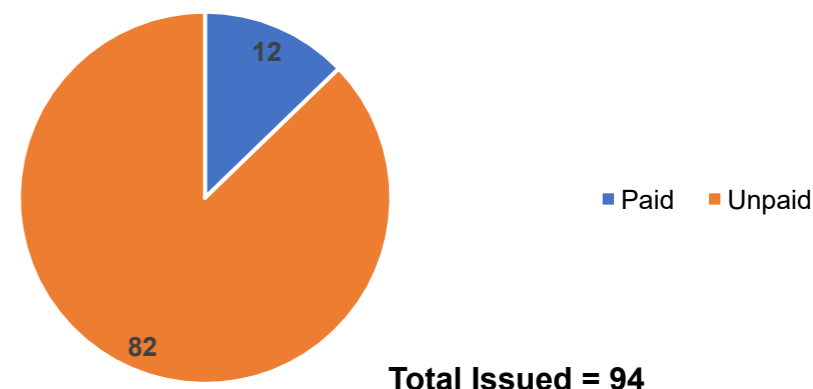
Key

- CPN Written Warning - Community Protection Notice Written Warning – precursor to CPN
- CPN - Community Protection Notice – used to stop a person/bus./org. committing ASB which spoils the community's quality of life
- PCO - Premises Closure Order – used to protect victims and communities by closing premises that are causing nuisance or disorder
- CBO - Criminal Behaviour Order – available on conviction of a criminal offence, used for the most serious and persistent offenders
- PSPO – Public Space Protection Order - enforced from December 2022

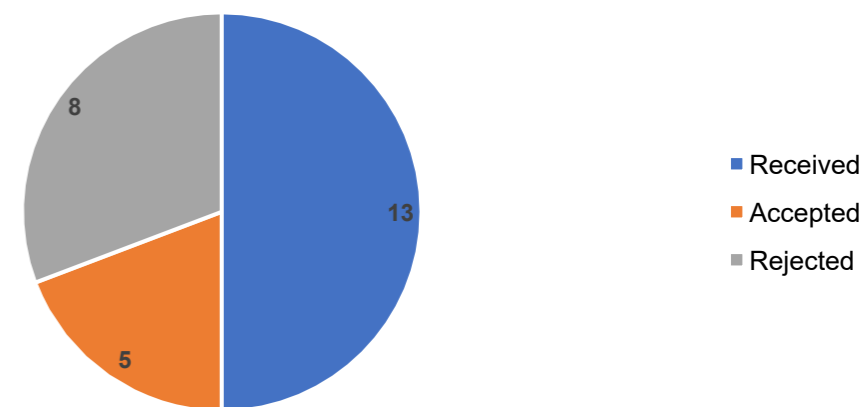

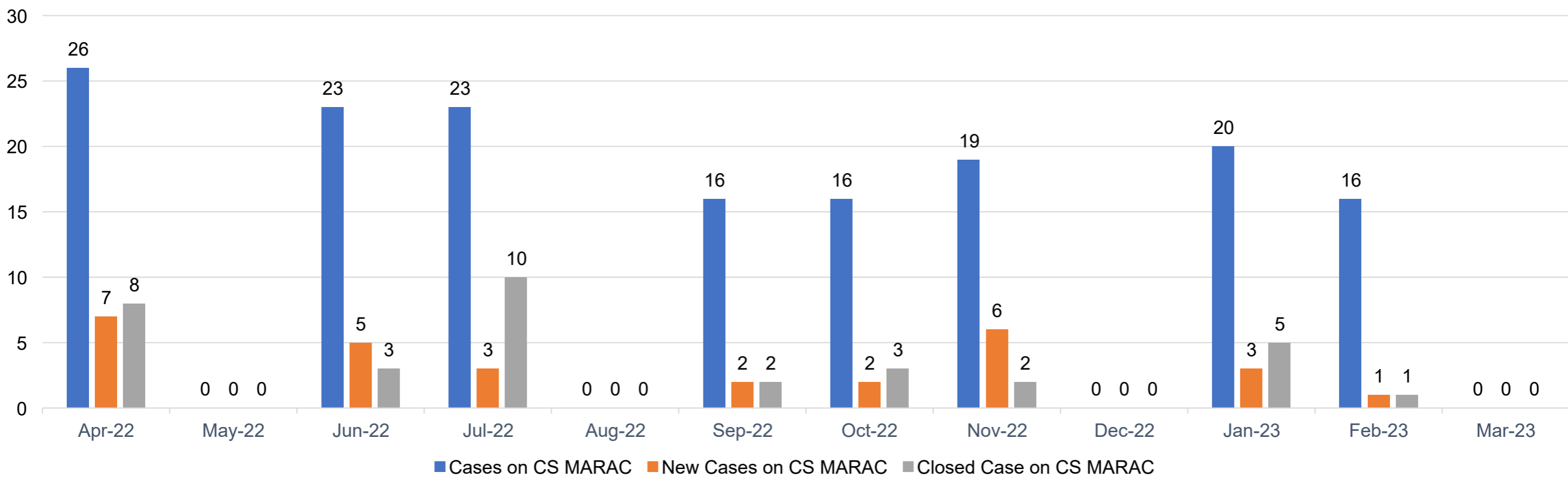

Between April 2022 - March 2023:

- Total CS MARAC cases average approx. 20 per month (ongoing cases, subject to actions from CS MARAC panel/partners)
- New CS MARAC cases average approx. 4 per month
- Closed CS MARAC cases average approx. 4 per month
- The CS MARAC is held every 6 weeks therefore there was no CS MARAC in May 2022, Aug 2022, Dec 2022 and Mar 2023

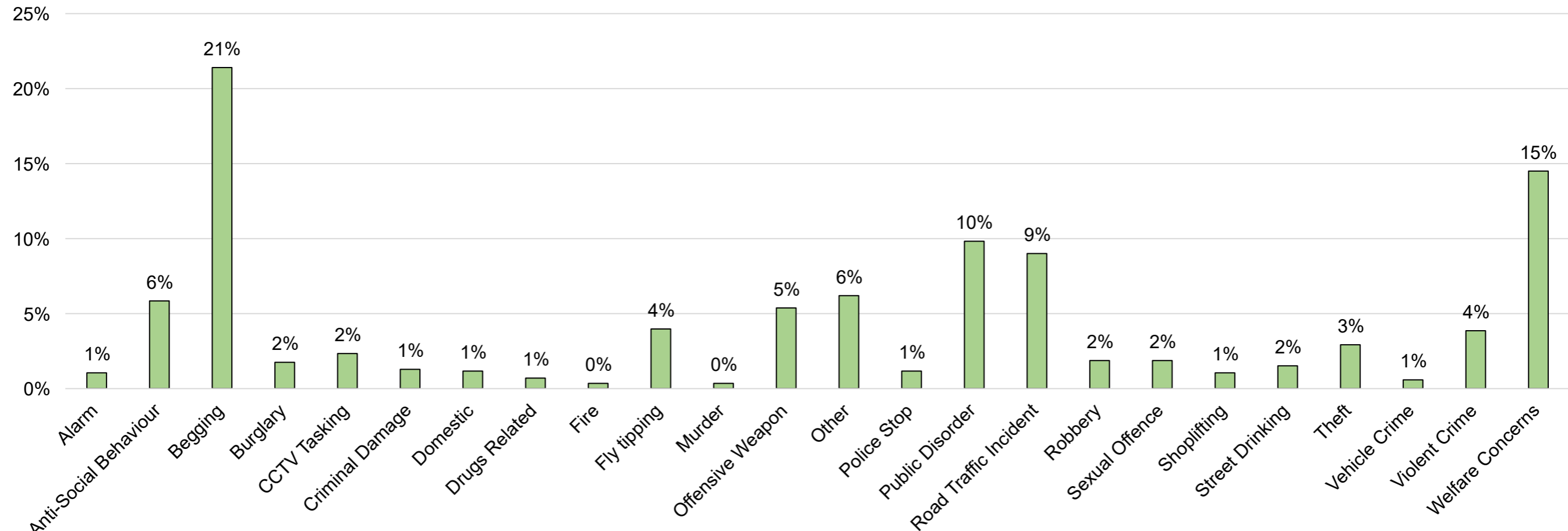

- 6% of CCTV incidents involved Anti-social Behaviour
- 6% of CCTV incidents involved Other

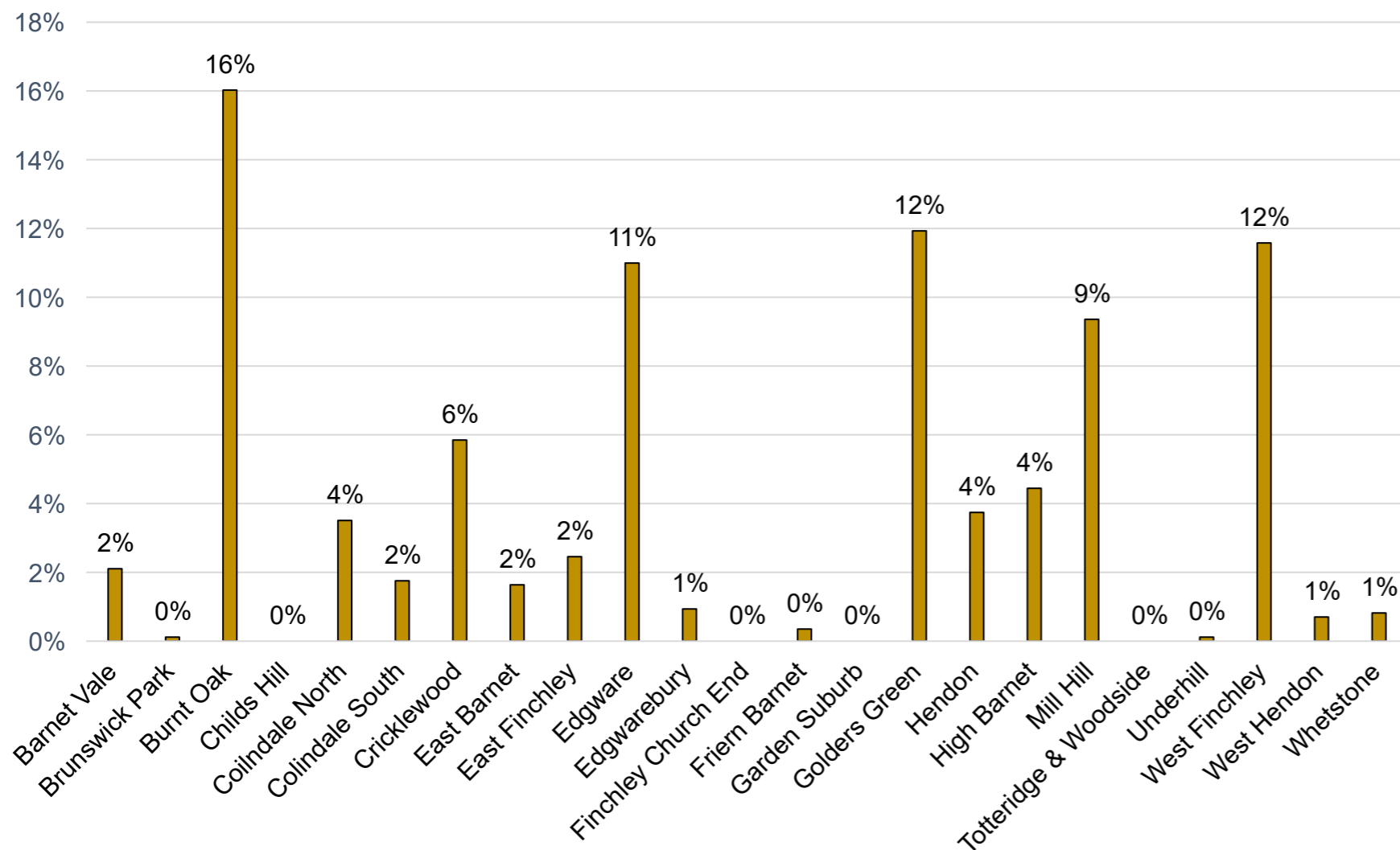

In West Finchley, the largest number of CCTV incidents captured was for Begging and Welfare Concerns.

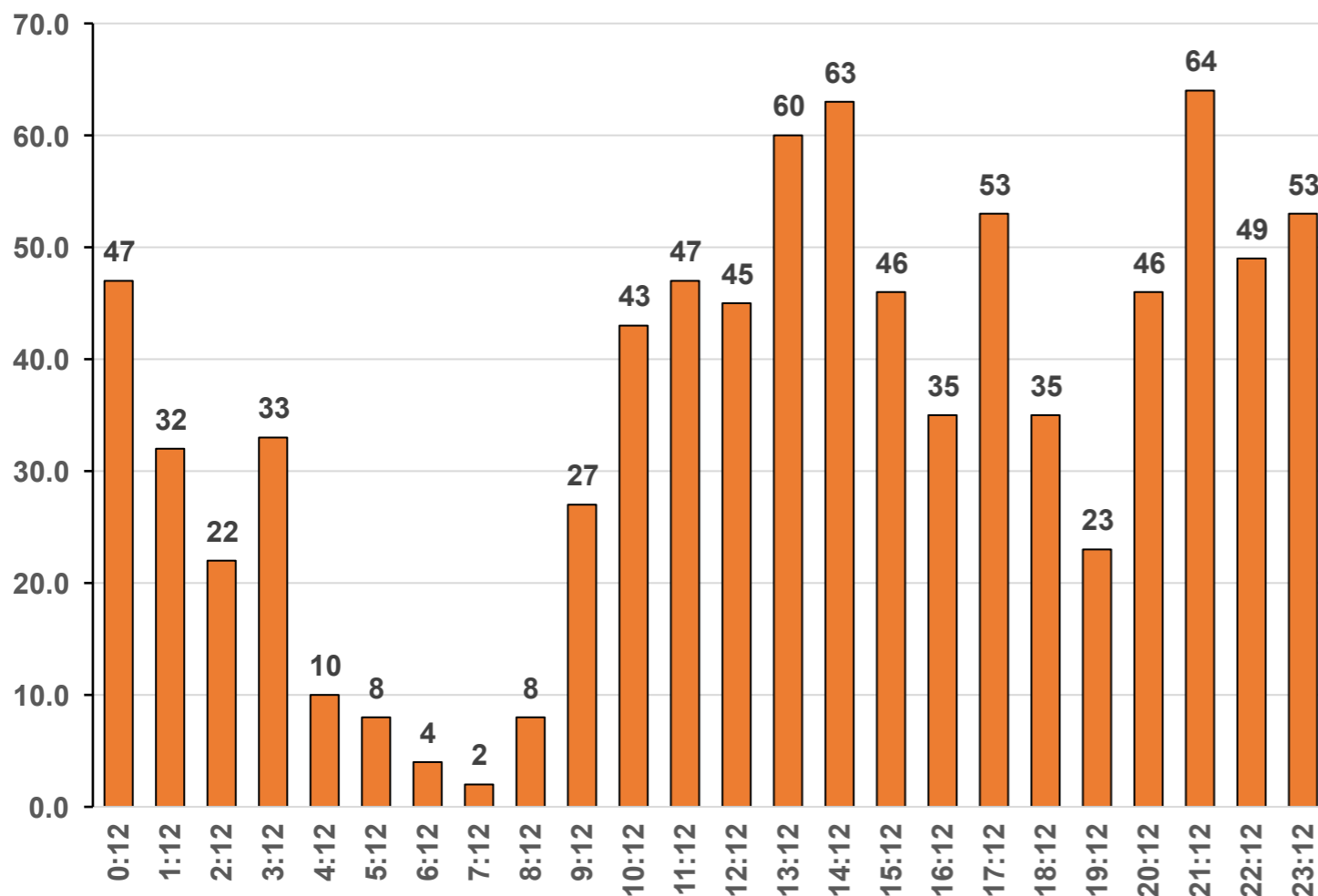

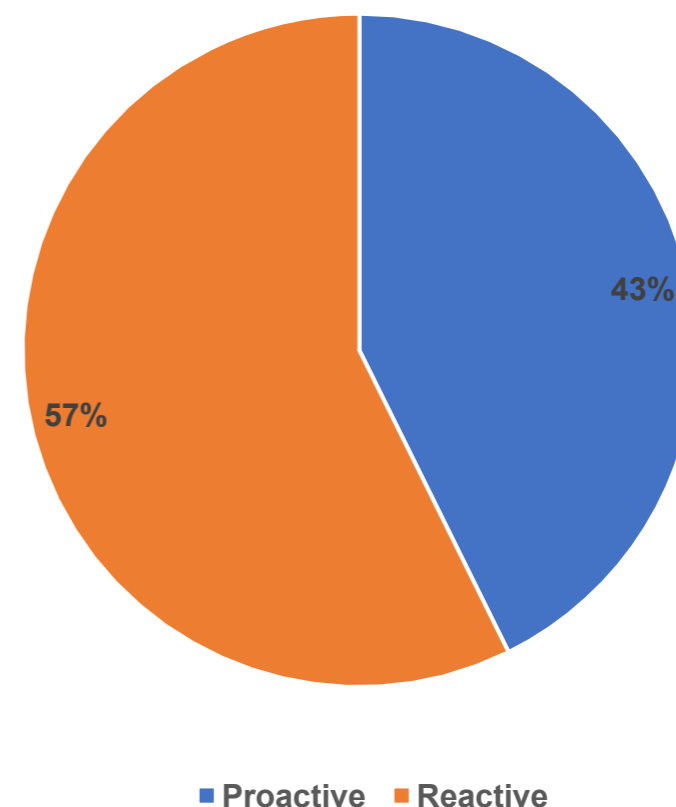
Time of Incidents: 6 months to March 2023

- The above pie chart shows majority of CCTV incidents captured are reactive. (The police or the council have asked the control room for assistance.)

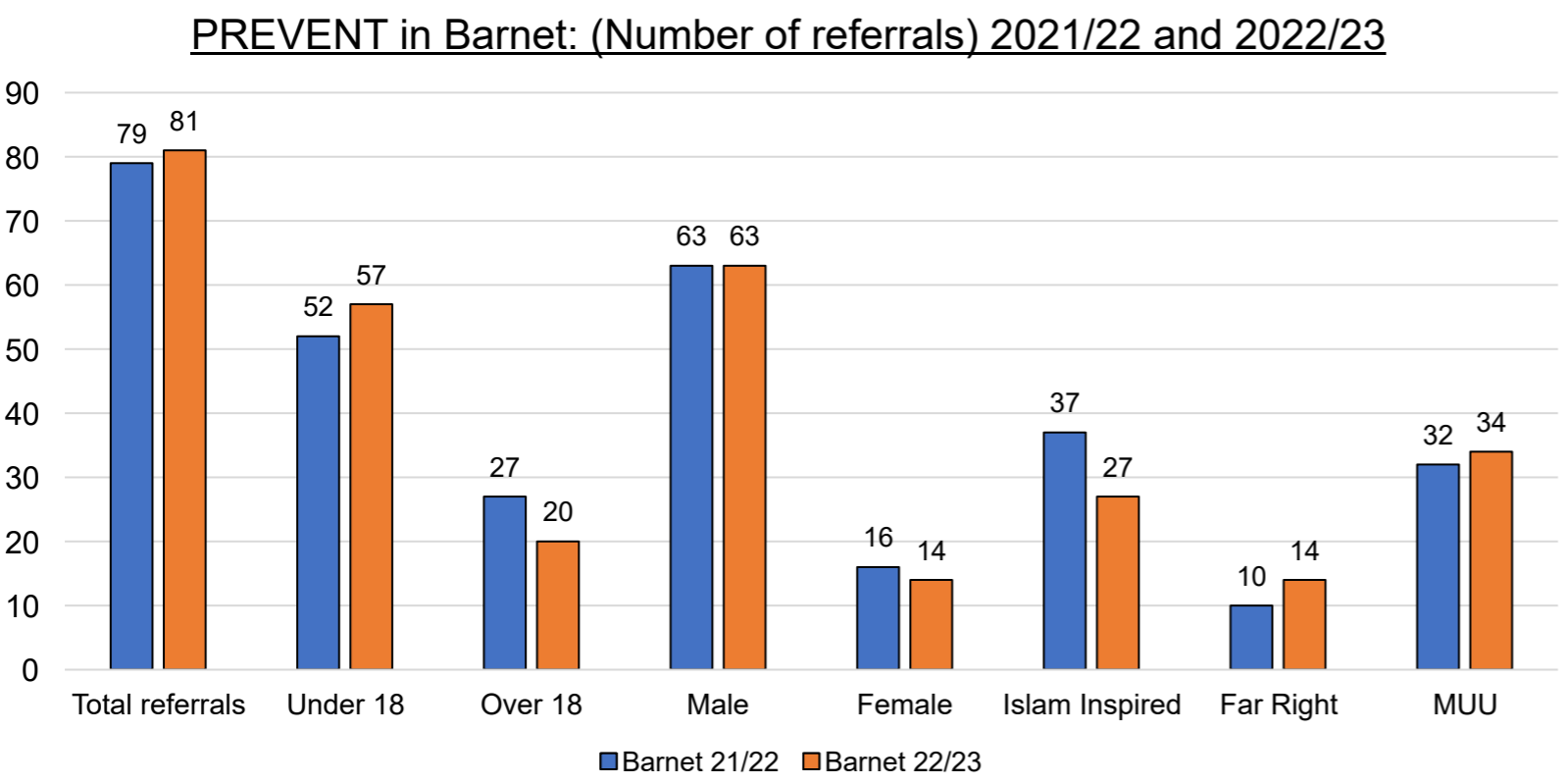
- The above chart shows the quietest periods are between 04:00am and 08:00am.

There were 81 PREVENT referrals in Barnet April 2022 – March 2023. In the previous year, there were 79.
This is an increase of 3%

In Barnet over the two comparable quarters of 2021/22 and 2022/23, the data shows majority of referrals involve:

- Male (78%)
- Under 18 (70%)
- MUU inspired (42%)

- In 2022/23 compared to the previous year:
- Total referrals increased by 2.5%
 - There was a 12.5% decrease in female referrals (down from 16 in 2021/22 to 14 in 2022/23)
 - Referrals of under 18's have increased by 9.6%
 - Islam Inspired referrals decreased by 27%
 - Mixed, Unstable and Unclear (MUU) referrals increased by 6.3%

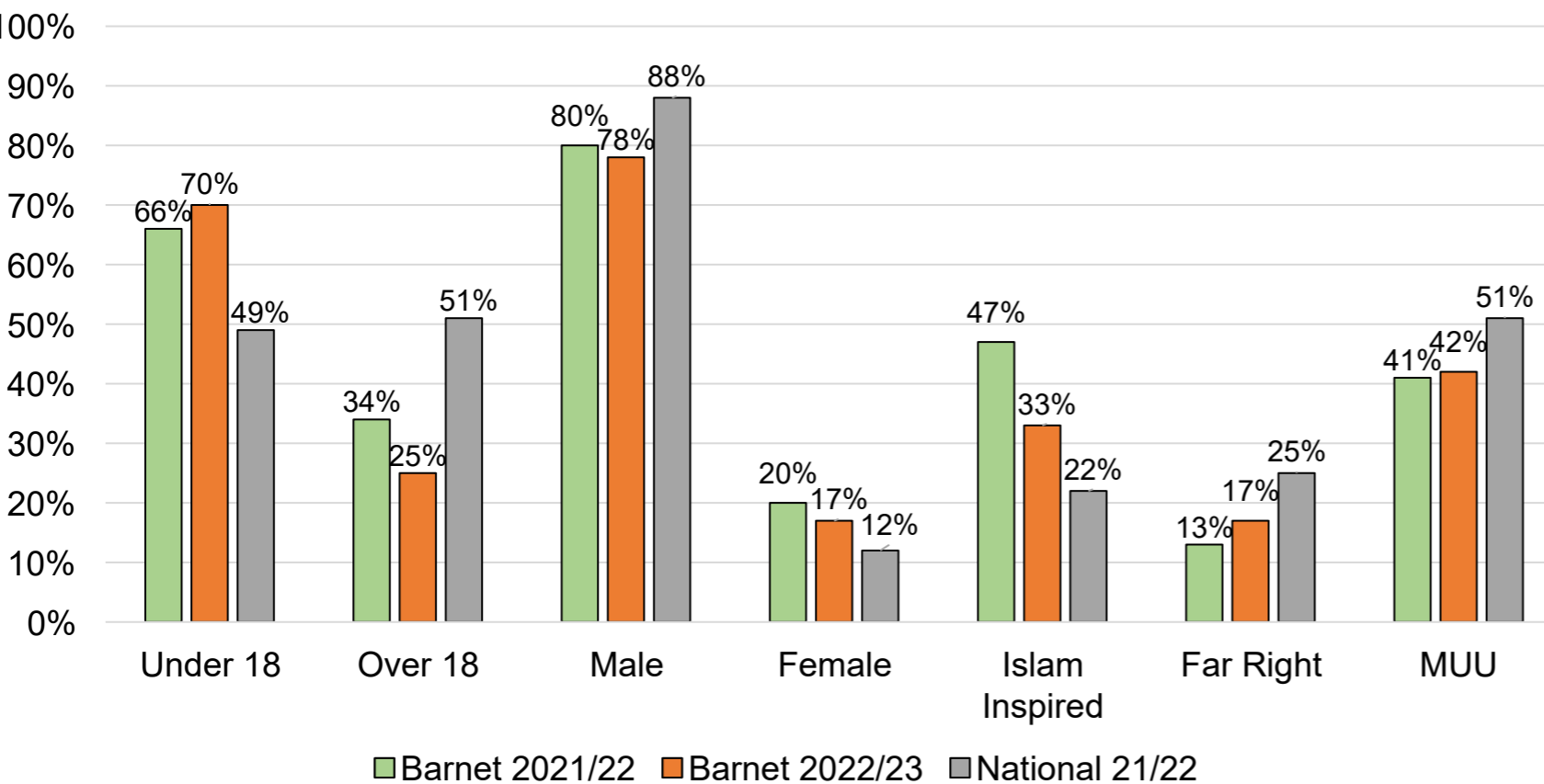
PREVENT: Percentage of Referrals - National Comparison

During 2022/23 in Barnet, compared to the National 2021/22 average there was:

- +21% point difference in under 18 referrals
- +5% difference in Female referrals
- +10% point difference in Islam inspired referrals
- -9% point difference in Mixed, Unstable and Unclear referrals (MUU)
