Recommendation:

The Cabinet approve the virements set out below noting that the pay inflation budgets being allocated to services are contained within the contingency budget set out in 7.4 of the Business Planning 2024-2030 and In-Year Budget Management 2023/24 report being presented to this Cabinet.

Pay Inflation virement:

At the beginning of November 2023, an agreement was reached on the pay award for Local Government Services for 2023/24. This equates to an increase of £2,229 for all full time equivalent up to the bottom of Grade L and a 3.88% increase for staff above that.

A separate agreement of 3.5% for all chief officers was reached earlier in the year and this virement includes budget allocations for these increases.

As detailed in 3.1.1 of the report at item 11, £8.576m had been put aside in contingency to cover this increase.
