### SCHEME SUMMARY

• To supply labour and equipment to replant approximately 20m of the bank between the A5 and Brockley Avenue, that has had the vegetation removed because of Dutch Elm disease.

• To plant 1.8m high Hawthorn, Beech and Red Robbin to form a screen and sound barrier for the houses in Brockley Avenue.
